**ORDER**

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Department of Education, Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh – 208024 had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council For Teacher Education for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. of One year from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 200 (Two Hundred) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following :-

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal / Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Department of Education, Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh – 208024 from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) students subject to fulfillment of the following :-

- (a) That the institution will ensure that Principal / Head and at least Seven faculty members are in position for an intake of 100 (One Hundred) students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Registrar of the concerned University shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- (b) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
