ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Anjali Institute of Management, Etemadpur, Agra, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council For Teacher Education for grant of recognition for starting **B.Ed. of One year** from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 120 (One Hundred Twenty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following :-

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 6,00,000.00 (Rupees Six Lac Only) and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 2,65,00,000.00 (Rupees Two Crore Sixty Five Lac Only).
- (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal / Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Anjali Institute of Management, Etemadpur, Agra, Uttar Pradesh** for **B.Ed. of One Year** from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) students subject to fulfillment of the following :-
