ORDER

Ripu Daman Singh College of Education, Agra Mathura National Highway, Sikandra, Agra - 282007 had applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education for seeking recognition of the B.Ed. course from the academic session 2002-2003 vide letter No. Nil dated 26.12.2001 and received on 31.12.2001.

2. The institution was inspected on 29.05.2002 by an Expert Committee constituted by this office. The Inspection Report of the Expert Committee, original file of the institution, copy of the NCTE Act, 1993, copy of the Norms and Standards and other relating documents were placed before the NRC in its 48th Meeting held on 25.06.2002.

3. After careful perusal of the file, Inspection Report and other related documents, the Committee decided that the institution, in light of the provisions contained under Section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993, be given an opportunity for making the written representation within one month from the date of issue of the letter of the following deficiencies noted in the case:

- (a) The institution was not shown the land documents to the inspection team and neither tell any reason for the same.
- (b) Non existence of Science lab.
- (c) Non existence of Play Grounds.
- (d) Non availability of Fund for Endowment Fund.
- (e) Non availability of journals for library.
- (f) Teacher was not selected and neither start the selection procedure.

4. As per the decision of NRC, a letter No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-686/6733 dated 22 July, 2002 was issued by Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education to the institution communicating deficiencies and giving an opportunity to make written representation within one months of date of issue of letter before refusing recognition of the proposed course on account of deficiencies noted above.
