ORDER

After enactment of National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (for short NCTE Act, 1993), the institution, namely, Handia P.G. College, Handia (Allahabad) was granted recognition for B. Ed. course with an annual intake of 70 students from academic session 2000-2001 by the Northern Regional Committee (for short NRC), Jaipur vide its order No. F-3/UP/56/B.Ed./2000/5816/23 dated 31.07.2000. The number of students was corrected to be 90 vide subsequent communication dated 01.12.2000.

2. AND WHEREAS, on the basis of the NOC of the State government dated 28.12.2003, the application of the aforesaid institution for additional intake of 100 students in B. Ed. course under self financing scheme from academic session 2004-2005 was considered by NRC in its 79th meeting held on 23rd and 24th June, 2004, wherein it was decided that the institution be informed of the deficiencies including essential requirement of Accreditation Certificate of B1 from NAAC as required by NCTE Regulations, 2003 as notified on 21 August, 2003. Consequently, the institution was intimated by the NRC vide its office letter dated 16.04.2004.

3. AND WHEREAS, on the basis of aforesaid NOC of the State Government dated 28.12.2003, vide covering letter dated 24.12.2004, the aforesaid institution has now made fresh application for B. Ed. course, as a new course under self financing scheme, with annual intake of 100 seats from academic session 2005-2006. However, in the application form it is deliberately concealed that the institution is already conducting B. Ed. course as aforesaid, after getting recognition from the NRC under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993. No Accreditation Certificate of B+ from NAAC has been submitted by the institution.

4. AND WHEREAS, the NRC considered the entire matter in its 96th meeting held on 20th and 21st September, 2005, and after careful perusal of entire file of the institution and taking into consideration the relevant provisions of the Act, Regulations and legal opinion obtained in this connection and having been satisfied that the requirement of Accreditation Certificate of B+ from NAAC as required by the amending Regulations, 2003 notified on 21.08.2003 is essential, decided to provide a reasonable opportunity to the institution for making written representation before refusing the present application. Consequently, the institution was intimated the above decision vide communication dated 06th October 2005. Pursuance thereof, the institution has made representation vide its communication-dated 14.10.2005.

5. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 97th meeting held on 27th and 28th October, 2005, after considering the entire matter including the representation and being satisfied that requirement of Accreditation Certificate of B1 from NAAC is essential, decided to refuse the aforesaid application of the institution.

6. AND THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of NRC, the application of the institution for B. Ed. course as applied for is hereby refused under Section 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

7. Consequently, the institution shall not admit any student in the B. Ed course as applied for and the examining body shall not grant affiliation for this course to the institution or hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise, if the said course is conducted by the institution without permission from NRC/NCTE.

8. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely B. Ed., obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi 110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
