ORDER

WHEREAS Achary Nanesh Shikshak Shiksha Mahavidyalaya, Near Gorhi Bhowri, Alanpur, Sawai Madhopur, Rajasthan had applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher education for seeking recognition of B.Ed. course from the academic session 2005-2006. The application was received in NRC Office on 31.12.2004.

2. WHEREAS, the institution was issued a letter dt. 10.06.2005 seeking an additional consent for inspection.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted reply communicating the consent for inspection vide its covering letter dt. 29.06.2005 received in NRC Office on 30.06.2005 and therefore, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 20.07.2005.

4. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 94th meeting considered the matter alongwith the Visiting Team Report and decided to issue the letter before refusing the recognition as per provisions contained under Section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act on account of the following deficiencies found in the Visiting Team Report and noted by the committee :-

- (i) The size of the classrooms is not as per NCTE norms.
- (ii) Accommodation for Hall is not provided.
- (iii) Playground is not provided.
- (iv) Chemicals and consumables in the required quantity have not been procured.
- (v) Instruments for simple experiments related to educational psychology have not been procured.
- (vi) Facilities for accessing and use of digital learning resources not provided.
- (vii) Access to Internet, Public address system not provided.
- (viii) Facilities for language learning not provided.
- (ix) The seating capacity in the library is only for 04 students, which is not sufficient for an intake of 100 students for B.Ed. Course.
- (x) The proposed land for the college of education is an Agricultural land.

5. AND WHEREAS, as per the above decision of NRC a Notice U/S 14(3)(b) was issued to the institution on 30.07.2005. The institution in its response submitted its reply vide its covering letter dt. 08.08.2005 received in NRC Office on 08.08.2005.

6. AND WHEREAS, the NRC considered the matter alongwith the reply submitted by the institution in its 95th meeting whereby the committee decided that second inspection of the institution be conducted to verify the facts claimed by the institution in its written representation.

7. AND WHEREAS, the second inspection of the institution was conducted on 17.09.2005. The Northern Regional Committee in its 96th meeting considered the matter and noted that the following deficiencies exist vis-à-vis NCTE norms :-

- (a) The temporary building for the proposed college of education is not suitable for running B. Ed. programme.

8. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in view of the above, decided to serve Show Cause Notice as to why the application cannot be rejected and the file be closed as the deficiencies persist even after an opportunity is given to the institution. The committee further decided that the institution may submit documentary proof duly certified by the competent authority w.r.t. each deficiency notified as above alongwith an Affidavit supporting the above points.

9. AND WHEREAS, in view of the above decision of NRC, a Show Cause Notice dt. 14.10.2005 was issued to the institution and in response the institution submitted its reply vide its covering letter dt. 25.10.2005 received in NRC Office on 26.10.2005.

10. AND WHEREAS, the Regional Committee considered the matter in its 98th meeting whereby the committee noted that the deficiencies pointed out in the Show Cause Notice still persist, hence, **decided to refuse recognition of the institution for B.Ed. Course.**

11. AND THEREFORE, **Achary Nanesh Shikshak Shiksha Mahavidyalaya, Near Gorhi Bhowri, Alanpur, Sawal Madhopur, Rajasthan** and other concerned bodies are advised not to admit any student in B.Ed. course in the said institute. In accordance to the Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993 ***the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.***

12. Further, if the Institution is not satisfied by the order, they can appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near TTO, New Delhi - 110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
