ORDER

WHEREAS, vide order No. F-3/UP 420/B. Ed./2000/7008t 9, 2000, the institution, namely, Bani Maharaj Institute of Management and Technology, Ramnreti, Virindaban, District Mathura (UP) was granted recognition for B. Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60 students by the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), Jaipur in exercise of powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Act, 1993. Thereafter, vide order No. F-3/NCTE/UP-555/2002/9862 dated 10 January, 2003 of NRC, permission to increase 40 seats in B. Ed. course from the academic session 2002-2003 was further granted to the institution so as to make complete one unit of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, vide covering letter dated 20.12.2003, delivered in the office of NRC on 30.12.2003, the aforesaid institution has made application seeking permission for additional intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

3. AND WHEREAS, vide notification dated 21st August, 2003, Regulations, 2002 dated 13th November, 2002 has been amended substituting clause (iv) of para 8 of the Regulations by the following: -

"No institution shall be permitted to apply for enhancement of its intake over and above the basic unit as indicated in the Appendices 3 to 14 of these regulations and for starting a new course or training in teacher education under sub-section (1) of Section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993 unless (a) It has been granted permanent recognition and has continuously run teacher training programme or course for a period of three years, and (b) it has accredited itself with the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with grade of B+ on a nine point scale developed by NAAC".

The aforesaid requirement was intimated to the institution by the NRC vide its communication No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1292/2004/2692 dated 8/9th June, 2004.

4. AND WHEREAS, since the above requirement was not fulfilled by the institution, the NRC in its 93rd meeting held on 27th and 28th June, 2005 decided to provide a reasonable opportunity to the institution for making a written representation before passing an order refusing the permission of additional intake as applied for by the institution. Accordingly the institution was intimated by the office of NRC vide its communication No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1292/2005/6186-6189 dated 20th July, 2005. Pursuant thereof, the institution made its representation vide its letter dated 28th July, 2005.

5. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 97th meeting held on 27th and 28th October, 2005, after considering the entire matter and the relevant provisions of the Act and Regulations and being satisfied that the institution has not been accredited with a grade of B+ by NAAC, which is mandatory requirement, decided to refuse permission for the additional intake of 100 seats for B. Ed. course.

6. AND THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of NRC, the application of the institution seeking permission for additional intake of 100 seats is hereby refused.

7. Consequently, the institution shall not admit any student in B. Ed course as applied for additional intake of 100 seats and the examining body shall not hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise, if the said course is conducted by the institution without permission from NRC/NCTE.

8. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely B. Ed., obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

9. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
