ORDER

21 DEC 2005

WHEREAS, the Northern Regional Committee (for short the NRC) in its 79th meeting, on the application of the institution, namely, Graduate School of Business and Administration (GSBA), Greater Noida (UP), decided to grant recognition to the said institution for the B. Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats from the academic session 2004-2005 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions before commencement of the academic session. Pursuant thereof, order No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-796/3645-3653 dated 06th July 2004 was issued by the NRC setting out those conditions in the order, which include: -

- Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/ State Government/ UGC is to be completed before the commencement of the course.
- The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Registrar of the concerned University should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session 2004-2005.
- The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.

2. AND WHEREAS, for physical verification of the facts regarding fulfillment of infrastructural and instructional facilities and other conditions subject to which recognition under sub section (3) of section 14 was granted to the institution and pursuant to general decision taken by the NRC in its 82nd meeting, an inspection team of experts was deputed by the NRC for making necessary inspection. The inspection was carried out by the said team on 01.02.2005 wherein certain deficiencies were noted.

3. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 88th meeting held on 23rd & 24th February, 2005, having considered the report of the inspection team and the deficiencies pointed out in the said report and being satisfied that the conditions subject to which recognition was granted to the institution were not fulfilled, decided to issue a show cause notice to the institution under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 giving it a reasonable opportunity of making representation against the proposed order. Consequently vide communication No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-796/14167 dated 09th March, 2005; a notice was given to the institution drawing its attention to the deficiencies noted by the visiting team and giving it one month time of making written representation.

4. AND WHEREAS, the entire matter was considered by the NRC in its 90th meeting and after careful perusal of the report of the visiting team and reply of the institution and being satisfied that conditions subject to which recognition was granted to the institution have not been fulfilled, decided to withdraw its recognition for the B. Ed. course from the end of current academic session i.e. 2004-2005. However, before this decision could be communicated to the institution, the NRC in its 94th meeting held on 21st and 23rd July, 2005, decided to give one more last opportunity to such institutions to remove the deficiencies before withdrawing their recognition. Consequently, the Manager/ Secretary of the institution was intimated accordingly by the NRC vide its communication dated 10th August, 2005 drawing their attention to the deficiencies and one more last opportunity to remove the deficiencies within one month and to submit documentary proof duly certified by the competent authority in support, in case of removal of the said deficiencies. In response thereof, the institution submitted its representation vide letter dated 05th September, 2005 alongwith certain documents and the same were considered by NRC in its 96th meeting held on 20th and 21st September, 2005 wherein the Committee decided to seek clarification regarding approval granted by the concerned affiliating University for appointment of faculty members as well an affidavit testifying the contents of the letter. The said decision was communicated to the institution by the NRC vide its letter dated 06th October 2005. The institution submitted its reply vide its letter dated 31st October 2005.

5. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 98th meeting held on 24th and 25th November, 2005 again considered the entire matter, including the deficiencies pointed out to the institution and the reply submitted by it in the light of the provisions of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE made/published from time to time and being satisfied that the deficiencies still persists, decided to withdraw the recognition granted to the institution for the B. Ed. course from the end of current academic session i.e. 2005-2006, in exercise of its powers under Section 17 of the Act.

6. AND THEREFORE, in terms of the above decision the recognition of the Graduate School of Business and Administration (GSBA), Greater Noida (UP) for the B. Ed. course stands withdrawn from the end of current academic session i.e. 2005-2006.

7. As a result of this order, Graduate School of Business and Administration (GSBA), Greater Noida (UP) shall discontinue the B. Ed. teacher training course immediately after the academic session 2005-2006 and the concerned University or examining body shall cancel affiliation of the institution in accordance with this order with effect from the end of the current academic session 2005-2006 as provided under sub-section (3) of section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.
