## ORDER

Malwa College of Physical Education, C/o Regional College of Management & Technology, Opp. NFL Township, Goniana Road, Bathinda, Punjab had applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher education for seeking recognition of B.P.Ed course from the academic session 2004-2005 vide letter dt. Nil. The application was received in NRC Office on 31.12.2003

2. The application of the institution was carried forward for the academic session 2005-2006 on the following deficiencies of essential documents :-

- Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs. 5.00 lakhs towards Endowment Fund in original in a Nationalized Bank for a period of 60 months has not been submitted.
- Legally valid land documents - The land documents submitted by the institute are in Gurmukhi and the same are not understandable for want of English / Hindi translation.
- Copy of the building plan approved by the competent authority - Building plan has been submitted but it does not contain any approval / sanction from the competent authority, as well, signatures of any functionary.

3. The institution submitted its reply / representation alongwith documents vide its letter No. Nil dt. 28.04.2004 received in NRC office on 29.04.2004.

4. The institution also preferred an Appeal U/S 18 of NCTE Act before the Appellate Authority of NCTE and the Appellate Authority vide its Order No. 89-136/2004/Appel dt 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 remanded back the case to Northern Regional Committee, Jaipur with the direction that the case of Malwa College of Physical Education, Bathinda, Punjab may be reprocessed.

5. In pursuance to the above direction of Appellate Authority, the institution was inspected on 05.12.2004 by an Expert Team constituted by the office of NRC. The Inspection Report of the Expert Team, original file of the institution, copy of the NCTE Act, 1993, copy of the Norms and standards and other related documents were placed before the NRC in its 87<sup>th</sup> meeting.

6. After careful perusal of the file, inspection report and other related documents, the Committee decided that the institution, in light of the provisions contained under Section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993, be given an opportunity for making a written representation within one month from the date of issue of the letter, w.r.t the following deficiencies noted in the case :-

- Approved building plan is not submitted.
