## ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, Indradev Institute of Education and Technology, Muradiagar Road, Boghpat (UP) has made an application to Northern Regional Committee (in short NRC) under section 15 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993 to seek permission to start new course of BTC from academic session 2004-2005 vide covering letter dated 30.12.2003 and the same was received in the office of NRC on 31,12,2003.

- 2. The institution was inspected on 30.11.2004 by an inspection team of expert constituted by NRC. The inspection team noted certain deficiencies in its report submitted and the same was considered by NRC in its 87th meeting held on 28-29 January, 2005 alongwith the original file of the institution.
- 3. After careful perusal of the file, inspection report of the experts and other related documents, the Committee, in the above meeting, being satisfied that the institution did not fulfill the requirements laid down in sub-clause (a) of section 15 (3) of NCTE Act, 1993 decided that the institution be given a reasonable opportunity for making representation drawing its attention with following deficiencies existed vis-à-vis NCTE norms:
- (i) The institution has not provided documentary proof with regards to purchase of equipments/ instruments/ consumable/ books/ journals etc.
- (ii) The accommodation provided for the existing course as well as proposed new programme is not sufficient.
- (iii) The institution has not provided multiple sets of Science Apparatus in Science Lab as per NCTE norms.
- (iv) The institution has not provided chemical and consumables in Science Lab as per NCTE norms.
- (v) Fucilities in the Science Lab are inadequately provided.
- (vi) The institution has procured 1070 books only in the library whereas the committee is of the view that a minimum of 1500 books is required for conducting the BTC course effectively.

(vii) Reserve Fund is not provided by the institution

Consequently as per above decision, letter No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP 1330/2004/12954 dated 10.02.2005 was issued communicating the above deficiencies to the institution with an opportunity to make representation within one month before passing an order refusing permission to the rizw course of BTC.

- 4. The institution submitted its written representation vide letter No. ITET/BTC Recog./103/2004-05 dated 04.03.2005 which was received in the office of NRC on 07.03.2005. The said representation was placed before the NRC in its 89th meeting held on 21st March, 2005 wherein the Committee, after consideration of the entire matter including the deficiencies referred to above, being of the opinion that the institution does not fulfill the requirements relating to norms and standards laid down for the same, passed an order refusing permission to the institution for the new course of BTC.
- 5. AND THEREFORE in terms of above decision of NRC, the application of Indradev Institute of Education and Technology, Muradingar Road, Baghput (UP) seeking permission for the new course of BTC is refused under section 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
- 6. Consequently, the institution shall not admit any student in BTC course and other concerned body(s) shall not hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise for the BTC course if conducted by the said institution unless the institution is granted permission for the said course by the NRC/NCTE.
- 7. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely BTC, obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.
