ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, Himachal College of Education, Nalagarh, Solan, Himachal Pradesh - 174101 has made an application to Northern Regional Committee (in short NRC) under section 15 (i) of NCTE Act, 1993 to seek permission to start new course of ETT from academic session 2004-2005 vide covering letter dated 16.01.2004 and the same was received in the office of NRC on 17.01.2004.

2. On preliminary scrutiny of the application, it was noted that the institution did not submit essential documents or the documents submitted by it are not proper as per norms and requirement laid down in Regulation, 2002 dated 13th November, 2002, hence the NRC in its 77th meeting decided to carry forward the above application for the session 2005-2006 and the said decision alongwith the said deficiencies was intimated to the institution vide letter dated 26/27.04.2004. Being aggrieved by this order, the institution preferred an appeal under section 18 of the NCTE Act and the appellate authority vide order dated 12.10.2004 remanded back the case to NRC with direction that the case of the institution may be reprocessed by causing inspection of the institution.

3. Accordingly the institution was inspected on 23.12.2004 by inspection team of experts considered by NRC. The inspection team noted certain deficiencies in its report and the same were considered by NRC in its 87th meeting held on 28-29 January, 2005 alongwith the original file of the institution.

4. After careful perusal of the file, inspection report of the experts and other related documents, the Committee, in the above meeting, being satisfied that the institution did not fulfill the requirements laid down in sub clause (a) of section 15 (3) of NCTE Act, 1993 decided that the institution be given a reasonable opportunity for making representation drawing its attention with following deficiencies existed vis-à-vis NCTE norms:
