ORDER

WHEREAS, the Northern Regional Committee (for short the NRC) in exercise of authority vested under section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE ALL, 1993 granted recognition to Sant Keenaram Post Graduate College, Roberts Ganj, Sonbhadra (UP) for B. Ed., one year course, from the academic year 1998-1999 with annual intake of 120 students vide Order No. F-3/UP-317/99/5811 dated 12st January, 1999, it was subject to the condition that the institution continues in fulfills the norms laid down under the Regulation and submission of Annual Report in this regard.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the decision taken in 72rd meeting, NRC decided to inspect the institution by them of experts on all aspects for the purposes of ascertaining that the institution is functioning in accordance the provisions of the NCTE Act and fulfills the norms faid down under Regulations issued by the NCTE from the time, including verification of the complaints. Accordingly, the inspection was carried out on 05.07.2004. The visite team noted certain deficiencies visite-vision NCTE norms in its report submitted to NRC. The report of the inspection and deficiencies printed out by it were considered by NRC in its 80rd meeting held on 26rd fi 27rd July, 2rd wherein it was decided that the institution he given an opportunity for making representation before decision in advantage of the NRCTE/F 3/UF-317/2004/5394 dated 06rd August 2004, the institution was intimuted known the deficiencies of the property of make written representation to NRC within 30 days.
- 1. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its representation/reply dated 03" September 2004 alongwith certain documents. Having considered all relevant documents, including the deficiencies pointed out by the visiting toain and written representation made by the institution, the NRC in its 85" meeting held on 04" & 05" November, 2004, decided that the institution may be inspected second time by an impecting team in view of certain facts mentioned in the representation. Consequently, the complete physical verification of unsimplify of all the inhastructural and assiructional facilities in the matrixion as per norms and Regulations of NCTE as well for verification of the facts immunicated by the institution in its written representation, the second inspection of the institution was carried out on 02" March, 2005 by a team of experts. The visiting toam submitted its inspection report to the NRC.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, the entire matter was considered by the RRC in its 90° mueting held on 22° & 20° April, 2005 and after careful pensal of all espects, other related documents and inspection reports of the inspection learns and the deficiencies position of the institution from the end of current academic session i.e. 2004-2005 on account of the following deficiencies:-
 - (i) The staff is paid the salary in cash instead of Cheque, which is not accreding to NCTE Rules and Regulations.
 - (ii) All toachers working are not qualified as per the NCTE norms and standards.
 - (iii) The name of Prof. S. N. Singh, a member NRC was shown in the list of quest faculty, which was denied by Prof. S. N. Singh in the meeting itself.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, after reconsideration on the cases in which withdrawal of recognition orders of NRC were not issued due to receipt of directions of NCTE HQs., New Delhi to do so and after careful consideration of the cases in which the decision was taken to withdraw / refuse recognition orders, the Committee decided to give one last opportunity to remove the decision to all the Institutions.
- AND WHEREAS, Notice Under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 wide ref. No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-317/2005/10162 dated 19,09/2005 was issued to the Institution to remove the aforesaid deficiencies within one month from the date of issue of this littler. The Institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 15.10.2005, which was considered by NRC in its 97th meeting, wherein the Committee decided to seek clarification from the authition regarding non-submission of Affidavit. Accordingly, a letter dated 19.11.2005 was issued to the Institution to furnish affidavit and also attested causes of relevant ducuments in support of removal of deficiencies to this office. The Institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 27.12.2065, which was considered by NRC in its 100° meeting, wherein the committee noted that the deficiencies quotes in para [iv] exist and the reply to the Show Cause Notice was submitted by the Principal and not by the Managembers. House, NRC decided to withdraw recognition granted to the Institution for B.Ed. Course from the standard or the scademic session 2005-2006.

- NOW THEREFORE, in terms of the above decision the recognition of Sant Keemaram Post Graduate College, Roberts Ganj, Sonbhadra (UP) for B.Ed. course is withdrawn from the current academic session i.e. 2005-2006.
- As a result of this order, Sant Keenaram Post Graduate College, Roberts Genj, Soribhadra, UP shall discontinue B. Et. teacher training course immediately after the academic session 2005-2006 and the concerned University or examining body shall cancel affiliation of the institution in accordance with this order with effect from the end of the current academic session 2005-2006 as provided under sub-section (3) of section 17 of the NCTE Act.
- The qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to that course or training or after undertaking a course or training in the said institution after the academic session 2005-2006, shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in my School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government as per sub-section (4) of the Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993.
- Further, If the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before NCTE, Headquarters. mainst this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. His guidelines for appeal are enclosed.
