ORDER

Bengal Institute of Education, Vill. - Jalaldiwal, On State Highway No. 13, Tehsil - Rajkot, Ludhiana, Punjab had applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher education for seeking recognition of B.Ed. course from the academic session 2004-2005. The application was received in NRC Office on 22.07.2004.

2. The application of the institution was carried forward for the academic session 2005-2006 on account of the following deficiencies in the essential documents:-

- (a) No Objection Certificate issued by the State Government has not been submitted.
- (b) Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs. 5.00 lakhs towards Endowment Fund in original in a Nationalized Bank for a period of 60 months has not been submitted.
- (c) Legally valid land documents - All the land documents submitted by the institution were in Gurmukhi, hence, institution was required to submit English / Hindi translation with proper attestation by competent authority to be true translation from the originals.
- (d) Land Title Certificate issued by a local practicing lawyer - The Land Title Certificate could only be considered after satisfactory submission of land documents.
- (e) Copy of the building plan approved by the competent authority - Photocopies of building plans submitted by the institution were neither signed nor contained approval / sanction from the local authority. From the said plans it was also not clear whether the building was already constructed or to be constructed. The institution was asked to submit proper blue prints of the building plan and also its approval / sanction.
- (f) Undertaking on non judicial stamp paper duly attested by the Notary - The undertaking submitted by the institution was neither on non judicial stamp paper, nor it was attested by Notary as required. Further, page 1 and 2 of the undertaking were not signed by the authorized functionary.
- (g) Sworn Affidavit verifying the contents given in the application form and the documents attached therewith duly attested through a First Class Magistrate / SDM / ADM - The Sworn Affidavit submitted by the institution was to be attested by Executive Magistrate verifies contents given in the application form only. The documents attached with the application form were not verified to be true and correct as required too.

- (h) From the perusal of the application format under point No. 1.9 and other related documents attached therewith, it was evinced that the affiliating University would be Shri Rawatpura Sarkar International University, Raipur, Chhatisgarh. As per the existing regulations dt. 13th Nov., 2002 framed by the NCTE, there is no provision for seeking affiliation from any University beyond the state and which is offering courses through its Study Centers, in so far as face-to-face mode B.Ed. is concerned. Therefore it is to be clarified that which will be the affiliating University for the applicant institute.

3. The institution submitted its reply / representation alongwith documents vide its letter No. Nil dated 25.10.2004 received in NRC office on 05.11.2004.

4. As per the decision of NRC taken in its 88th meeting a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on the following deficiencies of essential deficiencies :-

- (a) Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs. 5.00 lakhs towards Endowment Fund in original in a Nationalized Bank for a period of 60 months has submitted by the institution but the same is laminated and seems like a photocopy.

5. The institution further was issued a letter of conditional intent for seeking consent for inspection subject to satisfactory production of following document :-

- (a) Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs. 5.00 lakhs towards Endowment Fund in original in a Nationalized Bank for a period of 60 months has been submitted by the institution, but the same was laminated and seems like a photocopy. The original same FDR may be submitted.
- (b) The institution was also required to provide, Registration No. of the concerned Advocate issued by Bar Council of India who has signed the Land Title Certificate in your case as it was not mentioned in your Land Title Certificate.

6. The institution submitted its reply / representation alongwith documents vide its letter No. Nil dated 08.06.2005 received in NRC office on 14.06.2005.

7. The Regional Committee considered the matter in its 95th meeting whereby the committee noted that the institution submitted two FDRs in the name of Mrs. Milan Deb and the institution failed to submit the original FDR in the name of society / institution of which the coloured photocopy was submitted, therefore, the committee decided that the deficiencies communicated in the Show Cause Notice still exist. Hence, the NRC decided to reject the application of B.Ed. course and close the file.

8. Bengal Institute of Education, Vill. - Jalaldiwal, On State Highway No. 13, Tehsil - Rajkot, Ludhiana, Punjab and other concerned bodies are advised not to admit any student in B.Ed. course in the said institute. In accordance to the Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993 *the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.*
