**ORDER**

WHEREAS, Smt. Shanti Devi, Manager, of the Managing Society, namely, Shri Thakurji Maharaj Mahavidyalaya Samiti, Herwal, Distt. Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh had made application for recognition to start B. Ed. course in the name of the Institution, namely, Shri Thakurji Maharaj Mahavidyalaya, Safipur (Unnao) for academic session 2004-2005. In the said application on scrutiny and verification, it was confirmed that Fixed Deposit Receipts towards Endowment Fund was forged by making alteration from Rs. 5,000/- to Rs. 5,00,000/-. Hence, the NRC in its 88<sup>th</sup> meeting decided to cancel/reject the said application.

2. AND WHEREAS, vide covering letter dated 31.12.2004, Smt. Shanti Devi, the Manger of the above Institution and Managing Society has moved fresh application for recognition to start B. Ed. course from academic session 2005-2006 in the name of the Institution, namely, Shri Thakurji Maharaj Mahavidyalaya, Safipur i.e. in the same name as earlier. The 'No Objection Certificate' dated 04<sup>th</sup> July 2003 and land documents attached with the earlier application are the same in the present application.

3. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 90<sup>th</sup> meeting has taken a general decision that new applications received from such Institutions/ societies whose applications submitted in previous years could not be granted due to submissions of fraudulent documents be not considered.

4. AND THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of NRC, the above application, seeking recognition to start B. Ed. course is hereby refused.

5. Consequently, the Institution shall not admit any student in B. Ed course and the examining body shall neither grant affiliation to the Institution nor hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise for the B. Ed. course if conducted by the said Institution unless the Institution is granted permission for the said course by the NRC/NCTE.

6. In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely B. Ed., obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above Institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any School, College or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

7. Further, if the Institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
