ORDER

16 APR 2007

WHEREAS Ayodhya Prasad Memorial Degree College, Ujhani, Badaun, UP applied to Northern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education for seeking recognition of B.Ed. course from the academic session 2005-2006. The application was received in NRC Office on 27.01.2005.

AND WHEREAS, the application of the institution was scrutinized and a deficiency letter vide letter dt. 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2006 on the following deficiencies of essential documents :-

- (i) Legally Valid Land Document: The institution has submitted a photocopy of lease deed, the institution is required to submit a certified copy of lease deed in addition to certified copy of title deed of the lessor (Mr. Abhishek Agarwal). The institution may also clarify with regard to provision 4 of lease deed which make deed immovable and not free from all encumbrances as per the NCTE Rules & regulations. Accordingly the institution is required to submit / clarify the above deficiency.
- (ii) Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper duly attested by Oath Commissioner as per para 8 (6) of the Regulation dated 13.01.2006, which is given below :  
 (The institution / society shall furnish an Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper duly obtained by Oath Commissioner stating the precise location of the land (village, district, state etc), the total area in possession and the permission of the competent authority to use the land for educational purposes, mode of possession, i.e., ownership or lease)
- (iii) Details of your website including its URL (as per para 7 (6), 8 (7) and para 9 (1)), if applicable, of the above cited Regulation, relevant extract of which is quoted below :-  
 [Para 7 (6)- All the applicant institutions are expected to launch their own website simultaneously with the submission of their applications covering, inter alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the course applied for with links, availabilities of physical infrastructure (land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities) amenities, instructional facilities (laboratory, library etc) and the particulars of their proposed teaching and non-teaching staff etc with photographs for information of all concerned]

Para 8 (7)- The copy of the Affidavit shall be displayed by the institution on its official website so as to make the self-declaration available in the public domain.

Para 9 (3)- Following Statements of accounts, duly certified by a Chartered Accountant shall be maintained and displayed on its official website by every institution every financial year by 30th September of the year :-

- i. Balance Sheet as on the last date of the financial year
- ii. Profit and Loss Account for the financial year
- iii. Receipt and Payment Account for the financial year

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its reply vide covering letter dt. 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2006 and the reply was scrutinized and a conditional letter of intent vide letter dt. 14/07/2006 on the following deficiencies of essential document(s) :-

- 5. The institution has submitted an affidavit but not as per NCTE Rules & Regulations. The institution is required to submit an Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper duly attested by Oath Commissioner as per para 8 (6) of the Regulation dated 13.01.2006.

6. AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted its reply vide covering letter dt. 1<sup>st</sup> August 2006 and the inspection of the institution was conducted on 22.12.2006.

7. AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 112<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> Dec 2006 considered the matter along with the Visiting Team Report and Regional Committee noted that following deficiencies exists vis-a-vis NCTE norms :-

- The multipurpose hall is under construction.
- Access to Internet not provided.
- Facilities for language learning not provided
- The books provided in the library are only 2630, whereas as per NCTE norms, a minimum of 3000 books are required for effective curricular transaction.
- The institution to appoint the qualified staff by following selection committee procedure as per NCTE Norms/State Govt/Affiliating University.

8. AND WHEREAS, as per the above decision of NRC a Notice U/S 14(3)(b) was issued to the institution on 01.01.2007. The institution in its response submitted its reply vide its covering letter dt. 30.01.2007 received in NRC Office on 02.02.2007.

9. AND WHEREAS, the NRC considered the matter along with the reply submitted by the institution in its 113<sup>th</sup> meeting whereby the committee noted that the institution has not removed the deficiencies like hall provided is small and building is not adequate to run B.Ed course, NCTE norms, hence, decided to refuse recognition on the application submitted for B.Ed Course.

10. AND THEREFORE, Aymalha Prasad Memorial Degree College, Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh and other concerned bodies are advised not to admit any student in B.Ed. course in the said institute. In accordance to the Section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act, 1993 *the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.*

11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-H, I, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi - 110002 against this order under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
