**ORDER**

**5 JUN 2009**

WHEREAS National College of Physical Education, Village: Chupki, Post- Samana, District- Patiala, Punjab, was granted Conditional Recognition under para 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations dated 27<sup>th</sup> Dec 2005 vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/PB-370/2006/2997-99 dated 25<sup>th</sup> July 2006.

2. WHEREAS, as per the decision of NRC in its 122<sup>nd</sup> Meeting the Inspection u/s 17 of the institution was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> Dec 2007.

3. WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, Visiting Team Report, NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations and other documents were placed before the NRC in its 125<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21-22<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2008 whereby committee noted that the institution has been admitting the students in the C.P.ED Course without getting unconditional recognition from NCTE and decided that the clarification be sought from the institution and the University as to how the students have been admitted to the college without obtaining the unconditional recognition.

4. In response to the clarification issued by the office, the institution submitted a reply vide letter dated 07<sup>th</sup> Feb 2008.

5. WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, Reply received from the institution, NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations and other documents were placed before the NRC in its 126<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup>- 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb 2008 whereby on careful consideration of the reply, the committee decided that the Conditional Recognition granted to the institution u/s 7 (11) of the Regulation 2006 be rejected.

6. ANDWHEREAS the correspondent, National college of Physical Education (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 23.06.2008 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said order.

7. AND WHEREAS, after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, V.T. Report and after hearing the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council felt that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and the NRC's order was reversed with direction to the NRC to reconsider the list of staff appointed as furnished by the institution in response to the NRC's letter dated 25.07.2006 communicating decision of NRC to accept conditional recognition for running C.P.ED course and thereafter pass appropriate orders.

8. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the Institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and Ideography, recommendation of the State Government, in its 140<sup>th</sup> Meeting NRC considered the reply and the Committee was satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Elementary Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the Programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

9. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to **National College of Physical Education, Vill- Chupki, Post- Samana, Tehsil- Patiala, District- Patiala- 147101, Punjab** for conducting C.P.ED Course of Elementary (level) of one year duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty Only)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following:

10. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

11. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

12. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

13. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

15. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
