REFUSAL ORDER

17 JUL 2009

WHEREAS Institute of Professional Excellence & Management , A-13/1, South Side G.T. Road, Industrial Area, NH-24, Highway, Ghaziabad, U.P.had applied for grant of recognition (UP-2206) for **B.Ed. Additional intake** one years(s) duration under section **15 (1)** of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE.

2. AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution and the visiting team had since submitted its report.

3. AND WHEREAS in its 116TH (Second Sitting) meeting held on 7th - 8TH May 2007 the Northern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution decided to issue a **letter of conditional recognition and ask the institution Subject to appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the norms of NCTE/State Government./Affiliating University/Body given effect before the commencement of the B.Ed. Additional intake. Accordingly letter of conditional recognition was issued to the institution on 23.05.2007.**

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution has submitted reply, The matter was placed in NRC in its 141 meeting held on 22-24 May 2009. The original file of the institution, along with all other related documents, affidavits, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time, etc. were considered and the committee observes that:

- **The list of appointed Faculty as per NCTE Norms has not been submitted till date.**

5. AND WHEREAS the **committee decides to refuse recognition and return FDRs if submitted.**

6. NOW THEREFORE grant recognition to Institute of Professional Excellence & Management, A-13/1, South Side G.T. Road, Industrial Area, NH-24, Highway, Ghaziabad, U.P.for the course in B.Ed. Additional intake is hereby refused.
