ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Smt. Amrit Kunwar Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Atara Kalan, Via- Babai, District- Jalaun, U.P. submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting B.P.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty only) students on 27.06.2003;

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee was satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Physical Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the Programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms;

3. AND WHEREAS in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee granted recognition/permission in Smt. Amrit Kunwar Mahavidyalaya, VPO- Atara Kalan, Via- Babai, District- Jalaun, U.P. for conducting B.P.Ed (Secondary Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty Only) students from the academic session 2009-2010 under clause 7(I) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

4. Since the recognition was granted by NRC from the session 2009-2010, the institution was aggrieved with the order and filed an appeal in the NCTE HQtrs. The appellant authority considered the appeal of the institution and noted that the appellant institution was granted conditional recognition by NRC on 24.07.2006 for the commencement of the session 2006-07 and permanent affiliation was extended by the State Govt. from 2006 and unconditional recognition was issued by NRC only on 21.01.2009 w.e.f. 2009-2010 after a lapse of almost 3 years. This order would have been issued in continuation to the conditional recognition to regularize the interim period between 2006-2007 to 2009-2010. The University extended affiliation, admission of students by State Counseling Guide and the latest recognition order despite the institution was having infrastructure and instructional facilities as per norms. The Council came to a conclusion that there was enough justification in accepting the appeal, with a direction to NRC vide Appeal order No. F.No.59/207/2009 Appeal dated 13.7.2009 to issue unconditional recognition order in continuation of conditional recognition order dated 24.7.2006.

5. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order dated 21.01.2009 was set aside with direction to the NRC to issue unconditional recognition order in continuation in the conditional recognition order immediately.

7. NOW THEREFORE, the unconditional recognition order is issued in-continuation of the conditional recognition order dated 24.7.2006.

8. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever is applicable.

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10. The Institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of account accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T. D.S. in respect of the salary paid in the said. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated (provisions of Section 17(3) of the NCTE Act.

12. The institution shall maintain & preserve all documents as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always keep the following as mandatory disclosures:-

- * Copy of the Application Form;
- * Land and Building Particulars;
- * Staff Profile
- * Recognition letter
- * Information for having fulfilled the norms & standards and other required conditions.

13. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six months as the time of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the original documents regarding land intimated the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
