ORDER

WHEREAS IN terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1997 Amity University, Department of Education, Plot No. 4, Sector-125, Noide, District- G.B. Nagar, U.F. had submitted an application to the Morthern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition/permission for starting B.P.Ed Course of One year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty Only) students on 30.12.2005.

- AMD WHEREAS the original life of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 100<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Second Sitting) and 110<sup>th</sup> Meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 and 11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 at NCTE HQtrs, the committee decided to issue Conditional recognition subject to appointment of faulty members as per NCTE Norms and accordingly order was issued to the institution vide NCTE letter no. F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/8371-79 dated 14.11.2006.
- AND WHEREAS the applicant institution did not submit staff profile as per NCTE hurms and hence the matter was placed before MRC in its 141" Meeting held on 22" to 24" May 2009 and the committee decided to refuse the recognition for B.P.ED course of one year duration. Accordingly order was issued vide order no. F.NRC/NCTE/F73/UP-2051/141 MEETING/2009/5921-27 dated 09.07.2009. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 31.07.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi. Under section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 against the aloresaid order.
- AND WHEREAS after perusal of ripcuments, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments a lyanced during the hearing, the NCTE, New Delhi, reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, and accordingly remanded back the matter to NCTE NRC for issue of a revised under the yillidrawar of conditional recognition accorded to the institution NRC Order No. F.NRC/NC!E/F-7/8371-79 dated 14.11.2006 would be affective from the academic session 2010-2011 vide croer so. F.NO. 89-926/2009 -APPEAL dated 08.10.2009.
- NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 17(1) of the NOTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby withdraw the conditional recognition experded to the institution vide NRC Order No F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/8371-79 dated 14.11.2006 and the same would be effective from the
