ORDER

WHEREAS SARASWATI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, C/O M/S SHIV BHOLEY ROLLER, FLOUR MILLS (P) MILLS, 5th KM STONE, DABRA ROAD, HISSAR - 125005, HARYANA had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE, Jaipur for grant of recognition / permission for starting (HR-344) for B.Ed. course one years (1) duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred Only) students on 02.01.2006

2. AND WHEREAS in its 107th meeting held on 26th to 27th August 2006 the Northern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had decided to issue a letter of conditional recognition and ask the institution to appoint staff by a duly constituted selection committee with the requisite qualification as per Norms and Standards of NCTE and affiliating body and inform the Regional Committee by sending signed copy of the minutes alongwith an Affidavit. Accordingly a letter of conditional recognition was issued on 27.8.2006.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted representation to the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE. The matter was placed in 141st meeting held on 22nd to 24th May 2009. The Committee had decided to withdraw the conditional recognition granted to the institution. Accordingly withdrawal order was issued on 10.6.2009.

4. AND WHEREAS the institution had preferred an appeal on 08.06.2009 against the withdrawal order of NRC dated 10.6.2009 to the appellate authority. The appeal of the institution was accepted and NRC's order dated 10.6.2009 was set aside with direction to NRC to grant recognition to the institution immediately vide order dated 29.9.2009.

5. AND THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to SARASWATI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, C/O M/S SHIV BHOLEY ROLLER, FLOUR MILLS (P) MILLS, 5th KM STONE, DABRA ROAD, HISSAR - 125005, HARYANA for conducting B.Ed. Course of Secondary Level of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students from the academic session 2009-2010 under clause 7(1) of NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions as per the clarification from NCTE HQs letter No. file No. 48-3(1)/2008/NCTE/(N&S) dated 01.10.2009.

- I. The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date proscribed by the examining body for the academic session 2009-2010, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2010-2011 only.
- II. Formal orders for recognition / permission will operate for 2009-2010 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating body.

6. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and Reserve fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.

7. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

8. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007.

9. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

10. The Institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

12. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

13. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six months in the name of institution failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee alongwith the new land documents within stipulated time.
