**ORDER**

15 JUN 2010

WHEREAS in terms of Section **15(1)** of the NCTE Act, 1993 **S.D. College of Education Barnala, VPO- Barnala, Tehsil- Barnala, District- Barnala, Punjab** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **M.Ed** Course of **One year** duration with an annual intake of **25 (Twenty Five only)** students on **06.02.2008**.

2. AND WHEREAS the letter of Intent for inspection was issued to the institution on 30.04.2009. The Applicant institution had submitted the representation to the NRC NCTE on 06.07.2009.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the committee in its 144<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 and the committee decides to close file and return FDR's if submitted. Accordingly closed order was issued to the institution on 29.07.2009. The above said institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 16.09.2009 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order.

4. AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, set aside NRC's order and remand back the case to NRC for causing inspection of the institution to ascertain the availability of infrastructure and instructional facilities as per NCTE Norms and thereafter pass appropriate order.

5. AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution and the visiting team had since submitted its report.

6. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR, videography were duly considered by the NRC in its 157<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2010 and the committee decides to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.04.2010.

7. AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution has submitted its representation to the NRC NCTE on 16.04.2010. The matter was placed before the NRC in its 161<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2010 and the committee observes:

- **The photocopy of stock registers of purchase of Computers and material for Psychology lab have not been submitted.**

8. Hence, the committee decides to refuse recognition of M.Ed. course.

9. NOW THEREFORE recognition to **S.D. College of Education Barnala, VPO- Barnala, Tehsil- Barnala, District- Barnala, Punjab** for the course in **M.ED** in term of section 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 is hereby refused.

10. If the institution is not satisfied by the above order they can prefer an appeal to the council in terms of sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993.
