WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, **Sardar Rajinder Singh Memorial Mukat College of Education, Damanheri Road, Patiala Bye Pass, Near Railway Crossing, Rajpura, Punjab** has submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for starting **B.Ed. Course** of **one years** duration with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred only)** students on **30.12.2005**.

AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, The Northern Regional Committee in its 104th meeting held on 15 - 17 July, 2006 decided to issue a conditional recognition order. Accordingly conditional recognition order was issued to the institution vide order no. F.No. NRC/NCTE/F7/PB-356/2006/2918-2820 dt. 24.07.2006.


The institution submitted its reply on 21.08.2006. The original file of the institution, reply of the Institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 140th meeting held on 25th - 26th April, 2009 and the committee decided to ask the institution to submit the documents as prescribed in the NCTE Regulation with regard to appointment of faculty within 30 days. Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 02.06.2007 & 24.07.2009, correcting the name of the institution..

The institution submitted its reply on 12.08.2009. The original file of the institution, reply of the Institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 148th meeting held on 28th - 30th August, 2009 and the committee decided to refuse recognition for B.Ed. course. Accordingly, order of refusal of conditional recognition was issued on 09.02.2010 to the institution.

The institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqtrs, New Delhi on 13.10.2009. The Appeal Council accepted the appeal and NRC's order dt. 15.02.2010 was reversed with a direction to the NRC to issue formal recognition order in continuation to the conditional recognition order within 15 days of issue of this order vide its order dt. 31.05.2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee **hereby grants permission to Sardar Rajinder Singh Memorial Mukat College of Education, Damanheri Road, Patiala Bye Pass, Near Railway Crossing, Rajpura, Punjab** for conducting B.Ed. Course of Secondary (level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students **in continuation to the conditional recognition order** F.No. NRC/NCTE/F7/PB-356/2006/2918-2820 dt. 24.07.2006 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

- I. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along-with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007.



8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
10. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
11. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
