**ORDER**

**21 SEP 2010**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Guru Nanak Khalsa College, Near Fountain Chowk, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana (HR-440)** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **C.P.Ed. Course of Two years** duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty only)** students on **03.08.2006**.

2. AND WHEREAS the file of the institution was returned vide NRC order NO.NRC/NCTE/F-7/HR-440/142/2009/6210-6211 dated 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2009.

3. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal before the Appellate Authority and the Appeal Committee remanded back the case to NRC vide order dated 8.10.2009 with direction to cause inspection of the institution. The matter was placed in **151<sup>st</sup> NRC Meeting held from 20<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2009** and the Committee decided to process the file as directed by Appeal Committee. Accordingly the inspection of the institution was conducted on 13.12.2009. Further the reply of the institution dated 6.2.2010 was placed before the NRC in its 156<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from 22<sup>nd</sup> 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2010 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice on the following point:-

- The copy of the University letter regarding appointment of subject experts on selection committee has not been submitted.

Accordingly the Show Cause Notice was issued on 18.3.2010.

4. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution, reply of the institution dated 26.3.2010 along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its **159<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from 28<sup>th</sup> April to 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2010** and the Committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007. Accordingly the Letter of Intent Prior to Recognition **under clause 7(9) was issued on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2010**.

5. AND WHEREAS the original file of the institution, reply of the institution dated 26.3.2010 along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its **Emergent Meeting held from 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2010** and the Committee decided to issue letter **under clause 7(11) of regulations 2007**.

6. AND WHEREAS as per clarification received from NCTE, New Delhi vide letter No.48-6/PT-III/NCTE/(N&S) dated 31.8.2010 the Northern Regional Committee in its 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations, and letter of intent prior to the recognition under section 7 (9) of NCTE, Regulations, in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) or 7 (9) of NCTE, Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010 -2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal orders for recognition /permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

7. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Guru Nanak Khalsa College, Near Fountain Chowk, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana (HR-440)** for conducting **C.P.Ed. course** of two year duration with an annual intake of **50 (Fifty only) Students** under **clause 7(11)** of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- I) **The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010 -2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.**
- II) **Formal orders for recognition /permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.**
- III) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- IV) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- V) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007.

8. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

10. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

11. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

12. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, the institution must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
