WHEREAS, in terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Shri Ram Karan P.G. College, VPO- Bhimpura No. 1, Tehsil- Bilthra Road, District- Ballia, Uttar Pradesh has submitted an application to the NRC for grant of recognition/permission for conducting B.P.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty only) seats on 30.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution u/s 15 was conducted on 31.08.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the VTR along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 149th Meeting held on September 13-14, 2009 and the committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Show cause notice issued to the institution on 25.09.2009 on the following grounds:-

All labs are ill equipped.

Titles of Books and books are not as per Norms for B.P. Ed course.

Gym and TT facilities do not exist.

Playgrounds are not developed.

Playgrounds and tracks are not demarcated course-wise.

No facility for high and long jump.

AND WHEREAS, reply received was placed in the 154th Meeting held from January 09-11, 2010 and the committee decided that VT may be sent again.

AND WHEREAS, the re-inspection of the institution u/s 15 was conducted on 26.03.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the VTR along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 159th meeting held from April 28-May-01, 2010 and the committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Show cause notice issued to the institution on 14.05.2010 on the following grounds:-

- Number of titles of books is not as per NCTE norms for B.P.Ed and B.Ed. Courses.
- Library is being shared among B.A, B.Ed. and proposed B.P.Ed.
- The number of books is not as per NCTE norms for B.Ed. and B.P.Ed. Courses.
- Different labs, such as, Psychology, Physiology, ET, etc. are not in operation.
- Computers as per CD are not enough for all the courses run by the Institute.
- The size of shared Multipurpose Hall is not adequate for all courses run by the Institute.
- Playgrounds are not developed.

AND WHEREAS, reply received was placed in the 162nd Meeting held on June 24-27, 2010 and it was decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition issued on 22.07.2010

AND WHEREAS, the reply dated 19.07.2010 and 28.12.2010 received consequent upon the issue of Letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) dated 22.07.2010 was considered by NRC in its 177th Meeting held from January 27-29, 2011 and it was decided to issue formal recognition order for B.P.Ed. course with an intake of 50 seats under clause 7(11) and in terms of section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on $26^{\rm th}$ July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before
 the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed
 well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 20102011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Shri Ram Karan P.G. College, VPO- Bhimpura No. 1, Tehsil- Bilthra Road, District- Ballia, Uttar Pradesh for conducting B.P.Ed. Course of SEC-PE (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty only) seats from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
