**ORDER**

The 06 institutions mentioned in para 3 below submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to B.Ed., D.Ed. Add. and M.Ed. or equivalent courses in terms of Section 14 (1) and 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The NRC at its 107<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> August, 2006 considered the applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording etc. found the institutions mentioned in para 3 below fit for grant of conditional recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names. Thereafter the institutions submitted their replies and compliance for grant of recognition.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) and 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to these institutions w.e.f. the session 2006-2007 for the course and intake mentioned against the name and address shown as under:-

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following: -

- (a) The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength as per NCTE norms applicable to respective course/s approved. (1)
- (b) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- (c) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee. (2) 5 batch 9.3
- (d) That the Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions. (3) 3 batch F
- (e) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government / SCERT etc.
- (f) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (g) The institutions shall regularly update their website. (4)
- (h) The institutions intending to run the teacher training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to shift to their permanent building. They are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.
- (i) **The institution at S.No. 05 & 06 shall get the list of staff members ratified by the concerned University and send a copy to NRC, NCTE office, Jaipur.**
- (j) Attention of the institutions concerned is also drawn to Section 12 of NCTE Regulation dt. 27.12.2005 which reads as **"The institution concerned, after appointing the requisite faculty / staff, shall put the information on its official website and also formally inform the Regional Committee concerned. The Regional committee concerned shall then issue a formal unconditional recognition order."**

5. If any of the institution contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. The NCTE Hqrs. May also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.
