WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution i.e Apex College of Education, Khewat No. 283 Min, Sq. No. 179 Killa No. 10/2, 11, 20, 21, Village Dhani Bachan Singh, Tehsil Ellenabad, District Sirsa, Haryana has been recognized for B.Ed course by NRC vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/HR-1673/Appeal/166th Meeting/2010/27465-27471 dated 10th September 2010 with an annual intake of 100.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and has sought for two basic units in B.Ed., which requires additional facilities.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each, subject to the institution fulfilling the following conditions, namely:-

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Northern Regional Committee, with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as, land documents, non-encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents, if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith documents, if any, together with the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

5. Now therefore, in light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to Apex College of Education, Khewat No. 283 Min, Sq. No. 179 Killa No. 10/2, 11, 20, 21, Village Dhani Bachan Singh, Tehsil Ellenabad, District Sirsa, Haryana for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students, for two basic units of 50 students each, from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure.

- (a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
- (b) Name of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- (c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- (d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- (e) Fee charged from students.
- (f) Available infrastructural facilities.
- (g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
- (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.



ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Apex College of Education, VPO-Ellanabad, Tehsil-Ellanabad, Distt-Sirsa, Haryana (HR-1673) had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.Ed. Course of one year** duration with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred only)** students.

2. AND WHEREAS the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course was refused vide NRC's order dated 23rd April, 2009.

3. AND WHEREAS the institution has preferred an appeal on 01.01.2009 against the said order to the Appellate Authority. The appeal of the institution was accepted and the case was remanded back to the NRC for issuance of Letter of Intent Prior to recognition under Clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2007 vide order dated 26.11.2009.

4. AND WHEREAS the Letter of Intent Prior to Recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2007 was issued on 4th December, 2009.

5. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the NRC in its 155th Meeting held from 23rd to 25th January, 2010 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice on certain points. Accordingly the Show Cause Notice was issued on 20th February, 2010.

6. AND WHEREAS The original file of the institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its 159th Meeting held from 28th April to 1st May, 2010 and the committee observes the following:

• Mr. Haldhar Yadav appointed as Lecturer is not qualified to teach Methods of History, Economics and Geography. Hence, the committee decided to close file and return FDRs if submitted. Accordingly the order was issued on 12.5.2010.

7. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal on 13.5.2010 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi against the said order dt. 12.5.2010. The appeal of the institution was accepted and set aside NRC's order dated 12.5.2010 and remand back the case to NRC for examining the staff-profile of Dr. Samer Kumar Singh and issuing appropriate order thereafter.

8. AND WHEREAS the bio-data of Shri Sameer Kumar Singh, the candidate selected in place of Dr. Haldar was examined by Northern Regional Committee in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 and decided that Sri Sameer is a Arts graduate and had teaching of English subjects in its B.Ed. course. As such he was found eligible to teach Methodology of Social Sciences in B.Ed. course. Formal recognition order under clause 7(11) be issued from the academic session 2010-2011 for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students.

9. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Apex College of Education, VPO-Ellanabad, Tehsil-Ellanabad, Distt-Sirsa, Haryana (HR-1673) for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) Students under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations from the academic session 2010-2011 subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The admissions of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

- (ii) Formal order for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations.
10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
12. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
13. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
14. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, the institution must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
