WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted by the Northern Regional Committee to College of Applied Education & Health Science, Plot No. – A-22, Gangotri Colony, Village/Town – Meerut, Post Office - Krishna Nagar, Rudkree Road, Meerut, Tehsil/Taluka – Sardhana, Town City – Sardhana, District – Meerut, State – Uttar Pradesh, Pin Code - 250001 for B.Ed. course vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-3027/177<sup>th</sup> Meeting/2011/5013-5019 dated 08.02.2011 with an annual intake of 100 seats from the academic session 2010-2011 and Revised Order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-3027/2015/114301 dated 06.06.2015 was issued for an annual intake of 100 seats (2 unit of 50 student each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND, WHEREAS, a letter dated 06.10.2017 was received from Secretary, Meerut of Development Authority, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh the Society requesting for cancellation of recognition for B.Ed. course.


AND, WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 288<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from 05<sup>th</sup> to 07<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 and the Committee decided as under: -

- Letter received from the Secretary, Meerut Development Authority dated 26/09/2017 received in NRC office on 05/10/2017 clearly stated that the documents dated 02/07/2008 & 22/04/2009 submitted by the institution were not issued by the Meerut Development Authority.
- Reply of the SCN dated 25/01/2018 received on 23/02/2018 has not been found satisfactorily.

Hence, the Committee decided that recognition of the institution under Section 17 of the NCTE Act is withdrawn from the end of the academic session next following the date of order of withdrawal.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition of College of Applied Education & Health Science, Plot No. – A-22, Gangotri Colony, Village/Town – Meerut, Post Office - Krishna Nagar, Rudkree Road, Meerut, Tehsil/Taluka – Sardhana, Town City – Sardhana, District – Meerut, State – Uttar Pradesh, Pin Code - 250001 granted for B.Ed. course on the grounds mentioned above from the end of the academic session next following the date of order of withdrawal.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 College of Applied Education & Health Sciences, A-122, Gangotri Colony, Vill- Meerut, Post- Krishna Nagar PAC Meerut, Tehsil- Sardhana, District- Meerut, Uttar Pradesh has submitted an application to the NRC for grant of recognition for conducting B.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (One Hundred only) on 11.06.2008.

AND WHEREAS, Inspection of the institution conducted on 25.06.2009. The original file of the institution, VTR under section 14 along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the committee in its 146<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 05-07, 2009 and the committee decided to issue show cause notice to the institution. Accordingly, Show-cause notice issued on 12.08.2009 on the following grounds:-

- The land in on private lease which is not permissible as per NCTE Regulation 2007.
- As per letter dated 04-5-2009, the Institution was directed to register the land in the name of Institution within 90 days. This has not been done within the stipulated time.
- The land meant for B.Ed. course having khasra number 568 /2; and 569 is not sufficient as per NCTE norms for B.Ed.
- The land having khasra number 569 does not have CLU.
- Thirteen different courses approved by different bodies are being run from the same premise.
- Approved course-wise demarcated building plan has not been submitted.
- As per building plan, Multipurpose hall is small.
- Building maps submitted on 1 - 6 - 2009 are not readable.
- All laboratories are ill equipped and not proper.
- Playgrounds are not developed.
- The number of titles in the library is not as per NCTE norms.
- Language learning facilities are not adequate.

AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution, Reply of the Institution regarding SCN along with all other related documents were considered by the committee in its 149<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on September 13-14, 2009 and the committee decided to refuse recognition for B.Ed. course. Accordingly, refusal order issued to the institution on 29.10.2009 on the following grounds:-

- The bills for purchasing equipments are submitted but the stock register where the purchased equipments are entered is not submitted.
- The land registered in the name of Institution is on Khasra number 112 and plot numbers 72, 73, 74, and 75. All these plots are purchased only for residential purpose but not for running B.Ed. course. The building plan submitted is for khasra number 568 / 2 and 569 and these do not match.
- The bills for purchase of books are submitted but the photocopy of accession register where the purchased books are entered is not submitted.
- The playgrounds are still not developed.

AND WHEREAS, the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal dated 06.01.2010 to the NCTE, New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 31.05.2010 accepted the appeal and remand back the case to NRC for issuance of letter of intent prior to grant of recognition in respect of institution under Section 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations 2009 immediately.

AND WHEREAS, the said order was placed in the 162<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on June 24-27, 2010 and the committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of Regulations 2007. Accordingly, Letter of intent prior to recognition issued to the institution on 21.07.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of the institution dated 18.08.2010 consequent upon the issue of Letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) dated 21.07.2010 was considered by NRC in its 177<sup>th</sup> Meeting held from January 27-29, 2011 and it was decided to issue formal recognition order for B.Ed. course under clause 7(11) and in terms of section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 subject to the usual terms and conditions.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE has issued letter No.48-6/PT-III/ NCTE (N&S) dated 31.08.2010 in which it was stated that the matter regarding issue of recognition order under clause 7(9) or 7(11) of NCTE Regulations to the institution which were found eligible for grant of recognition order on merit but where order could not be issued due to the ban imposed by the NCTE on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 has been considered by the Council and it is clarified that such pending orders now be issued. This is due to the consideration that the present ban is only on fresh receipt of application for the academic session 2011-2012 and therefore the old pending cases are to be disposed on merit without any reference to the ban.

AND WHEREAS, the above letter of NCTE, Headquarter was considered by NRC in its 166<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 and NRC decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) of NCTE Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to College of Applied Education & Health Sciences, A-122, Gangotri Colony, Vill- Meerut, Post- Krishna Nagar PAC Meerut, Tehsil- Sardhana, District- Meerut, Uttar Pradesh for conducting B.Ed Course of Secondary (Level) of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred Only) students from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:-

- The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.


If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
