ORDER

In continuation of this office order even no. dated 13.08.2006, the two institutions mentioned in para 3 below submitted application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition of B.Ed. course in term of section 14(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The NRC at its 106th meeting held on 11th-12th August 2006 at NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi, considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Report, Video Recording etc. found the institutions mentioned in para 3 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested under section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to these institutions w.e.f. the session 2006-2007 for the course and intake mentioned against their names and address shown as under:

4. The institution shall ensure the fulfillment of the following:-

- The institution shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1:7 for the proposed B.Ed. Course.
- The institution shall note that with regard to NET/ SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only up to the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.07.2006.
- The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institution shall within one month of the receipt of Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/institution.
- Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
