PREAMBLE :

Soundaraa Teacher Training Institute, RS No. 141, Elayangudy, Thirunallar Commune, Karaikal – 609 607, Pondicherry has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary (D.T.Ed)** course on 10.02.2004 along with NOC dated 10.02.2004 issued by the U.T. Government of Pondicherry.

SRC-NCTE caused inspection of the institution on 31.08.2005. The visiting team report and other documents furnished by the institution were placed before SRC in its 104th meeting held on 23-24 September, 2005. SRC considered the visiting team report and other documents of the institution and decided to accord recognition to the institution to offer D.T.Ed. course from the year 2006-07 with an intake of 100 as the documents submitted by the institution were belated for being considered for the academic year 2005-06 in view of Appendix 1-B of NCTE Regulations, 2002. Accordingly a recognition order was issued on 18.10.2005. Subsequently SRC in its 104th meeting held on November 8-9, 2005 decided to seek clarification from the institution since the land deed was not registered. A letter communicating the decision of the SRC was issued to the institution on 8.12.2005. The written representation submitted by the institution was placed before 107th SRC meeting held on 27.12.2005 and SRC decided to reject the proposal.

The Chairman SRC on 2.2.2006 has issued a preliminaries addendum. As per the preliminaries addendum SRC decided to modify the decision of 107th meeting held on 27.12.2005 in respect of the institution and decided to accord recognition for the D.T.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 from the session 2005-06. In the mean time the institution aggrieved by the recognition order issued by NCTE, granting recognition from the academic session 2006-07, preferred an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in NCTE Headquarters, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority vide their order No. 89-197 2005-Appeal dated 22.2.2006 has decided to reverse the order appealed against.

Hence the order.

Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Soundaraa Teacher Training Institute, RS No. 141, Elayangudy, Thirunallar Commune, Karaikal - 609 607, Pondicherry** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary (D.T.Ed)** course of two year duration from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **100** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of three years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 Lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the **Principal and Eleven Teachers** for the said course.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Soundaraa Teacher Training Institute, RS No. 141, Elayangudy, Thirunallar Commune, Karaikal - 609 607, Pondicherry** for Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of **two year** duration from the session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **100** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that **Twelve** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Eleven teachers**) duly approved, by the Directorate of School Education, Pondicherry are in position for an intake of **100** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.

: 3 :

1. The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
2. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
3. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating authority to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
