Preamble:

Jeyasuriya Self Employment Teacher Education Trust, Villupuram, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for C.P.Ed Course.

Subsequently, inspection team was deputed and the report/s were placed before the Southern Regional Committee. The SRC in its meeting held on 17-18 July, 2006 considered the report and decided to send a copy of the application to State Government of Tamilnadu seeking recommendation as per the NCTE Regulations 13.01.2006 as the institution has not submitted NOC / Endorsement from the State Government. Accordingly copy of the application was sent to the State Government of Tamilnadu.

Meanwhile, the applicant institution has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and submitted a court direction in W.P.23576/2006 wherein Hon'ble court has directed SRC-NCTE to pass orders in accordance with law within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of the order. The directions of Hon'ble Court was placed before SRC in its meeting held 1-2 August, 2006. SRC resolved to refer the matter to standing counsel for legal opinion. The standing counsel has offered his legal opinion in his letter dated 16.08.2006. The legal opinion was placed before SRC in its meeting held on 22-23 August, 2006.

SRC considered the legal opinion obtained in this regard and has taken decision to accord recognition to the applicant institution from the session 2006-07

Hence the order.

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 lakhs.
- The institution has selected the <u>Principal and five</u> lecturers for the said course.
- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Jeyasuriya Teacher Education and Training College, 3/139, Jeyasuriya Mahal, Vignesh Nagar, Trichy Main Road, Villupuram-605401, Tamilnadu for C.P.Ed course of Two Years duration from the academic session 2006-2007 with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that <u>Principal and Five</u> faculty members duly approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai are in position for an intake of <u>50</u> students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
 - b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
- 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
