ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Church Park Anglo-Indian Teacher Training School, Chennai - 600006, Tamilnadu for Elementary Course** of two years duration from the academic session **2000-2001** with an annual intake of **37** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year six additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. Instructors for Work Experience, Art & Music should be appointed as per NCTE norms.
3. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University/ State Government as the case may be.
4. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
5. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
6. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
7. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

if **Church Park Anglo-Indian Teacher Training School, Chennai - 600006, Tamilnadu** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


The Performance Appraisal Report submitted by you vide letter dated 23-05-2001 was reviewed by the SRC and the intake in respect of your institution for the year 2001-2002 has been fixed at 40 subject to fulfillment of following conditions:

- All management staff appointed should be on regular basis and extended Govt. approved scales of pay as per NCTE norms. Documentary proof in this respect should reach this office before the end of September 2001.
- All such teachers already appointed prior to March 2000 who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms before the completion of the academic year 2001-2002.

In case you desire to have the original intake restored, you may appoint — number of qualified teachers based on which SRC-NCTE will restore the intake subject to production of documentary proof like certificates of qualifications, date of appointment, joining report, proof of salary etc., as applicable.

In view of the above you are hereby instructed to make admissions for the year 2001-2002 with an intake of 40 only. (forty only).
