Preamble

Read: Notification of NCTE, New Delhi dated 1.1.2004 published in the Gazette of India Part III-Section 4 as No. 3 on 5.1.2004.

The NCTE, New Delhi in its Notification dated 01.01.2004 decided to dispense with the requirement of "No Objection Certificate" from State/UT Government for those institutions already running Elementary programmes recognized by NCTE and seeking recognition to start a course or training in increase in intake for a period of three years from the date of notification of these regulations in the Official Gazette.

Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Garden, Andarkuppam, Kundrathur, Chennai – 600 069, Tamilnadu which has been granted recognition by SRC-NCTE has submitted an application for increase in intake for Elementary (D.T.Ed) course by deriving the benefit of above said regulation on 31.12.2004.

The application for increase in intake of Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Garden, Andarkuppam, Kundrathur, Chennai – 600 069, Tamilnadu was considered by SRC-NCTE under section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, inspection of the institution was carried out on 4.6.2005 and the report of inspection team and other documents furnished by the institution along with the application were considered by the Southern Regional Committee in its 97th meeting held on 27th July, 2005. The Regional Committee observed that the institution had made satisfactory arrangements in respect of infrastructural and instructional facilities for proposed increase in intake and decided to permit the institution with an additional intake of 50, thus making the total intake capacity of 100 from the session 2005-06. Hence the order.

Order

In terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Garden, Andarkuppam, Kundrathur, Chennai – 600 069, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for increase in intake of Elementary (D.T.Ed) course of two years from the academic session **2005-06** with an additional intake of **50** students.



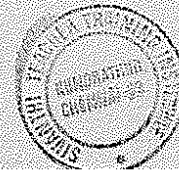
2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **Eleven** teachers for the said course, which is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Garden, Andarkuppam, Kundrathur, Chennai - 600 069, Tamilnadu** for Elementary (D.T.Ed) course of **two years duration** from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **100** students which includes the existing intake of **50** and an additional intake of **50**, subject to fulfillment of the following.


- a. The institution will ensure that **Twelve** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Eleven teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **100** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
- b. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
- c. FDR for endowment fund should be converted in the joint name of the Regional Director, SRC-NCTE and the management representative if it is not already done.

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4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of Teacher Education Research and Training (DTERT) to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.



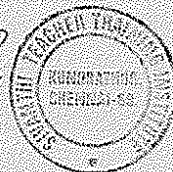

ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Pattanathar Educational Trust, Chennai, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Nagar, Udankudi, Thisaianvilai Road, Meyyur post, Tuticorin District-628203, Tamilnadu for Elementary(D.T.Ed) Course of two years duration from the academic session 2006-07 with an annual intake of 50 students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in the rented premises
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs 5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 lakhs
 - d. The institution has selected the Principal and five teachers for the said course.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, hereby grants recognition to Sivanthi Teacher Training Institute, Sivanthi Nagar, Udankudi, Thisaianvilai Road, Meyyur post, Tuticorin District-628203, Tamilnadu for Elementary (D.T.Ed) course of two years duration from the academic session 2006-2007 with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Five faculty members duly approved by DTERT, Chennai are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

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- b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Director, DTERT, Chennai to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
