PREAMBLE :

Sri Thiyagaraja Institute of Teacher Education, 15-B, Bigmill Street, Vijayapuram, Thiruvarur - 610 001, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Elementary (D.T.Ed) course on 06.01.2003 without NOC/Endorsement from the State Government of Tamilnadu.

In the light of the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on February 7, 2004, vide CA 1068/2003, and subsequent directions from the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, SRC caused inspection of the institution on 18.06.2004. SRC considered the visiting team report of the institution and had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and decided to issue notice under Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act. A notice was issued on 08.09.2004. The written representation submitted by the institution was placed before 81st SRC meeting held on 11.10.2004. SRC considered the written representation and came to the conclusion that the recognition to the said institution be refused. A rejection order was issued to the institution on 02.11.2004.

Aggrieved by the rejection order the institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Headquarters, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority vide their order No. 89-300/2004 Appeal dated 27.12.2004 confirmed the order appealed against. The institution brought a court direction passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 485 of 2005 and W.P.M.P. 375 of 2005 quashing the rejection order issued by SRC-NCTE and with a direction to pass appropriate orders, taking into account the contention of the institution that all the defects have been rectified. The institution has filed a contempt proceeding No. 342 of 2005 for not passing orders within a time limit stipulated by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras.

In obedience to the directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras SRC decided to cause re-visit of the institution. A second visit was organized on 10.06.2005 and the visiting team report was placed before 93rd SRC meeting held on 15.06.2005. SRC considered the visiting team report and decided to call for the list of staff approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai before granting recognition. A letter to the institution conveying the decision of SRC was issued on 06.07.2005. SRC in its 98th meeting held on 10th August, 2005 decided to defer the decision as the institution failed to submit staff list approved by the Director, DTERT. Due to non-submission of staff list approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai SRC in its 100th meeting held on 23-24. September, 2005, decided to reject the proposal of the institution. A rejection order to the institution was issued on 3.11.2005 mentioning the reason for rejection.

The institution has brought a court direction passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 38155 of 2005 and W.P.M.P. No. 42068 of 2005 dated 20.12.2005 directing NCTE to consider the matter afresh as the order is passed without proper application of mind. The matter was placed before SRC in its 108th meeting held on 17-18 January, 2006. SRC decided to cause inspection of the institution. Accordingly a visit was organized on 22.2.2006 and the visiting team report was placed before SRC in its 110th meeting held on 24.2.2006. SRC decided to accord recognition to the institution to conduct D.T.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 from the academic session 2006-07.

ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sri Thiyyagaraja Institute of Teacher Education, 15-B, Bigmill Street, Vijayapuram, Thiruvavur - 610 001, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary Teacher Training (D.T.Ed.)** Course of **two years** duration from the academic session 2004-05.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
- c. The Institution has created an Endowment fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve fund of Rs. 3.00 lakh.
- d. The institution has selected the Principal and Five teachers for the said course.

3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Sri Thyagaraja Institute of Teacher Education, 15-B, Bigmill Street, Vijayapuram, Thiruvarur - 610 001, Tamilnadu to offer Elementary (D.T.Ed.) course of two years duration from the academic session 2006-07 with an annual intake of 50 students, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a) The institution will ensure that **Six exclusive faculty members (Principal and Five teachers)** duly approved by the Directorate of School Education are in position for an intake of 50 students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.


4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The recognition order is subject to, the outcome of appeal, if any filed by NCTE before the Supreme Court of India.

7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
