PREAMBLE :

Preamble

Sri.Satya Sai Teacher Training Institute, Mahalakshmi Street, T.Nagar, Chennai had submitted a representation requesting for permission for shifting from temporary location to the permanent premises at 217-218, Pattabiramapu ram Village, Tiruttani Tq, Tiruvalluvar District, Tamilandu.

Further the judgement from the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 21035 of 2007 dated 22.06.2007 was received wherein the Hon'ble court has directed NCTE to pass appropriate orders within four weeks.

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Court, an inspection of the institution was carried out at the new premises at Tiruttani on 13.09.2007.

The inspection report was considered by SRC in its 145th meeting held on 16-18 October 2007. The committee considered the matter and decided to seek recommendations from the State Government of Tamilnadu by providing 21 days. As per the decision of SRC, letter was sent to the State Government of Tamilnadu on 02.11.2007. Further one more letter was sent to the State Government on 07.12.2007. Even after the span of two months there was no reply from the State Government.

The matter was again placed before SRC in its 151st meeting held on 7-8 January 2008 along with the letter received from the Advocate for not obeying of court orders and will be moved for contempt. SRC considered the matter and decided to obtain legal opinion on the contempt notice received and also authorised Regional Director to take decision in consultation with Chairman, SRC based on the legal opinion.

As per the decision of SRC, a detailed letter was addressed to Sri.M.T.Arunan, Standing Counsel for NCTE at High Court of Madras seeking opinion on the matter on 17.01.2008. In reply, the advocate in his letter dated 22.01.2008 has offered his opinion stating that NCTE very well can pass appropriate order as per the provision of the NCTE at the earliest.

Further a letter to the Chairman, SRC along with the detail of the institution, VT report and the legal opinion of Sri.M.T.Arunan was sent on 23.01.2008 seeking his decision on the matter as per the authorisation given by SRC. In reply the Chairman, SRC in his fax dated 01.02.2008 has informed his decision stating "order for shifting the premises of the above teacher training institute may be issued".

In view of the above, permission is hereby accorded to Sri.Satya Sai Teacher Training Institute for shifting to its own premises at B.K.R. Nagar, Chennai Tirupati Highway, Pattabhirampuram Village, P.O. Tiruttani – 631209, Tiruvallur District, Tamilnadu.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sola Raju Dhanuskodi Raja Thai Ammal Memorial Educational Charitable Trust, Chennai District, Tamilnadu** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for shifting of institution to **Sri Sathya Sai Teacher Training Institute, B.K.R Nagar, Chennai Tirupati Highway, Pattabhirampuram Village, Tiruttani-631209, Tiruvallur District, Tamilnadu** for **Elementary(D.T.Ed)** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **100(Hundred)** Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Sri Sathya Sai Teacher Training Institute, B.K.R Nagar, Chennai Tirupati Highway, Pattabhirampuram Village, Tiruttani-631209, Tiruvallur District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **(D.T.Ed)** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **100(Hundred)** students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated.13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii) The institution will ensure that **Principal and Eight** faculty members duly approved by DTERT, Chennai are in position for an intake of **100** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
