ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Al-Hidhaya Women's Teacher Training Institute, No. 21, Pudumanai 2nd Street, Tenkasi - 627811, Tirunelveli District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for D.T.Ed & D.T.Ed-AI Courses.

AND WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Committee, after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials granted recognition to the institution for D.T.Ed course on 30.03.2005 with an annual intake of 50 students and D.T.Ed-AI course on 30.08.2006 with an intake of 50 students, thus making an annual intake of 100 students, which includes the existing intake of 50 and additional intake of 50 students, with stipulation that the institution shall shift to its own premises/building within three years from the date of recognition.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide its letter dated 28.09.2007 & 12.01.2009 submitted Rs.40,000/- for shifting of premises at 2.8-77/2, College Road, (Via) Tenkasi-Elathur, Tirunelveli District-627803, Tamilnadu. Accordingly the inspection of the institution at the proposed premises for shifting was fixed between 7-11 March 2011. The same was intimated to the institution on 04.03.2011. Accordingly inspection of the institution was conducted on 11.03.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 203rd meeting held on 31st March & 1st April 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.05.2011. The institution had submitted in its reply on 14.07.2011.

- 1) The Committee considered the reply of the institution dt. 14.07.2011, VT report of the institution and all other related documents along with the original file of the institution and decided that shifting to new/permanent premises be permitted for D.T.Ed (APS02738) course only.
- 2) The Committee considered further the written reply of the institution dt. 14.07.2011 on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition for the following reasons:-

- The management is running Two Teachers Training courses in the same building, and no earmarked built up area for each of the course/programme. The total built up area is 11241 sq.ft. which is inadequate for both D.T.Ed and D.T.Ed-AI Teacher Education Programmes as per NCTE norms. A total built up area of 21,000 Sq.ft is required for both D.T.Ed and D.T.Ed-AI.


AND WHEREAS, based on the above points the SRC in its 211th meeting held on 21-23 September, 2011 decided to withdraw the recognition of the D.T.Ed-AI (APS4422) course run by the Al-Hidhaya Women's Teacher Training Institute, No. 872, Aykudi Road, Vahini Building, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli-627811, Tamilnadu, from the academic year 2013-14, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in D.T.Ed- AI (APS04422) course, if any, to complete their course.

NOW THEREFORE, permission is hereby accorded by SRC to Al-Hidhaya Women's Teacher Training Institute, No. 21, Pudumanai 2nd Street, Tenkasi - 627811, Tirunelveli District, Tamilnadu to shift its premises to the new location / building at Al-Hidhaya Women's Teacher Training Institute, 2.8. 77/2, College Road, Via-Thenkasi, Elathur, Thirunelveli District, Pin-627803, Tamilnadu for D.T.Ed course (APS02738).

If the institution contravenes any of the conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
