ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Jayanthi Padmanaba Teacher Training Institute, 46/16, Northcar Street, Srimushnam-608703, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary(D.T.Ed) Teacher Training Course of two years duration** from the academic session **2005-06**.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
- The institution has created an Endowment fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve fund of Rs. 3.00 lakhs.
- The institution has selected the **Principal** and **five** teachers for the said course and the staff list is not approved by the DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Jayanthi Padmanaba Teacher Training Institute, 46/16, Northcar Street, Srimushnam-608703, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu** to offer **Elementary (D.T.Ed) course of two years duration** from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **50** students, subject to fulfillment of the following:-


- The institution will ensure that **Six** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Five teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **50** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the course. The faculty list is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.
- The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course started in temporary premises).



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- c. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
  - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
  5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating authority to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.


WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Jayanthimala Educational Trust, Cuddalore District, Tamilnadu has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Jayanthi Padmanabha Teacher Training Institute, No. 46/16, North Car Street, Srimushanam, Kattumannar Koil Taluk, Cuddalore District-608703, Tamilnadu for Elementary D.T.Ed(Additional Intake) course of two years for an additional intake of 50 (Fifty) Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Jayanthi Padmanabha Teacher Training Institute, No. 46/16, North Car Street, Srimushanam, Kattumannar Koil Taluk, Cuddalore District-608703, Tamilnadu for conducting Elementary D.T.Ed(Additional Intake) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100(Hundred) students which includes the existing intake of 50(Fifty) and an additional intake of 50(Fifty) under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated 13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
  - i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
  - ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - iii) The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)

students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

- 4 Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
- 5 The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6 The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
- 7 If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**ORDER**

WHEREAS, Jayanthi Padmanaba Teacher Training Institute, 46/16, North Car Street, Srimushanam, Kattumannar Koil Taluk, Cuddalore District-608703, Tamilnadu has submitted application for seeking grant of recognition for D.T.ED course.



The institution submitted its reply on 13.05.2011 for the following alongwith D.D. dt.12.5.2011 as earlier D.D. is stated to be out dated.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee considered the reply of the institution dt. 13.05.2011, VT report of the institution, and other related documents along with the original file of the institution and decided to continue recognition accorded to the institution.
