#### PREAMBLE:

Devarajan Teacher Training Institute, No. 2/54, Agarangadu, Thennampulam, Vedaranyam Taluk, Nagapattinam District-614806, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Elementary(D.T.Ed) course.

Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 29232 of 2005 has directed NCTE to cause inspection within a period of twelve weeks. Accordingly, an inspection was carried out on 11.10.2005. The inspection report was placed before 103<sup>rd</sup> SRC meeting held during 27-28<sup>th</sup> October, 2005.

After considering the application and other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 17.11.2005 to the applicant institution under provisio to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

The institution has submitted written representation dated 23.11.2005 which was placed before SRC in its 106<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15-16<sup>th</sup> December, 2005. SRC considered the written representation submitted by the above institution and decided to organise revisit to verify the submission of the applicant. Accordingly a revisit has been organised to the institution on 26.12.2005. The visit report was placed before SRC in its 107<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> December 2005 and hence SRC decided to accord recognition with an annual intake of 50 from the session 2005-06.

Some of the institutions who have been granted recognition for the subsequent year have preferred appeal before NCTE, New Delhi to reconsider their cases of grant of recognition for the session 2005-06 itself instead of 2006-07. The NCTE, New Delhi vide order No.F.No.89/156/2005-Appeal dated 28.9.2005 has remanded back the case to SRC with a direction to reconsider these cases immediately for grant of recognition for the session 2005-06 on par with other similar cases who have been grated recognition for 2005-2006.

SRC in its 104<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 9-10 November, has considered the legal opinion obtained in this regard and has taken decision to grant recognition to the session 2005-06 to those institutions who have submitted belated NOC's/Endorsements and also the essential documents mentioned in Appendix-1B of NCTE Regulations as one time exception.

Hence the order.

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Devarajan Teacher Training Institute, No. 2/54, Agarangadu, Thennampulam, Vedaranyam Taluk, Nagapattinam District-614806, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of two year duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 50 students.

- 2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in the rented premises.
- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 Lakhs.
- d. The institution has selected the **Principal and Five** lecturers for the said course.
- 3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Devarajan Teacher Training Institute, No. 2/54, Agarangadu, Thennampulam, Vedaranyam Taluk, Nagapattinam District-614806, Tamilnadu for Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of two year duration from the session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following.
- a. The institution will ensure that **Six** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and Five teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **50** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course.
- b. The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).





- c. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
- 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating authority to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
