**ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Mahamuth Ammal Educational Trust, Pudukkottai District, Tamilnadu has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Mahamuth Ammal Teacher Training Institute, Ariyur, Annavasal Road, Illupur Taluk, Mathiyanallore Post, Pudukkottai District-622101, Tamilnadu for Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) Students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Mahamuth Ammal Teacher Training Institute, Ariyur, Annavasal Road, Illupur Taluk, Mathiyanallore Post, Pudukkottai District-622101, Tamilnadu for conducting Elementary(D.T.Ed) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty) students under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated 13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfilment of the following.

i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.

ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.


iii) The institution will ensure that Principal and Five faculty members duly approved by DTERT, Chennai are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**Sub: Grant of conditional recognition for starting D.T.Ed-AI Course – reg.**

In terms of section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the above Society / Trust / Institution had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting D.T.Ed-AI course of two Years duration with an additional intake of 50 students at Annavaasal Road, Ariyur, Mathiyanaallore Post, Iluppur Taluk, Pudukkottai District-622101, Tamilnadu.

2. On the basis of the scrutiny of the documents submitted by the institution, input received from the Visiting Team Report and videography, the SRC in its 158th Meeting of SRC held on 13-14 May, 2008, has decided to grant conditional recognition to the above institution as per para 7(11) of Regulations of NCTE Notification dated 27.12.2005 published in the Gazette of India on 13.01.2006.

3. Now the institution shall undertake appointment of the faculty / staff by a duly constituted selection committee and ensure selection of candidates possessing qualifications as prescribed under rules. (A duly constituted selection means that a nominee of the affiliating body / University as applicable, subject expert of the affiliating body / University and a nominee of the State Government appointed by the affiliating University and the State Government respectively).

4. Terms and conditions of service of staff are to be maintained as per NCTE norms and standards.

5. Attention of the institutions concerned is also drawn to para 7(12) of NCTE Regulations which reads as "The institution concerned, after appointing the requisite faculty/staff, shall put the information on its official website and also formally inform the Regional Committee concerned. The Regional Committee concerned shall then issue a formal unconditional recognition order". Hence the institutions shall host the details in the institution website and thereafter submit the details to SRC-NCTE.

6. Besides the above, the institution is required to submit the following:

- Annexure – I - An Affidavit on Rs.100/- stamp paper to the effect that the institution has appointed staff as per NCTE/State/University norms.

- b. Annexure - II - An affidavit on Rs.10/- non judicial stamp paper by the individual faculty member appointed by the institution
- c. Annexure - III - Details should be filled by every faculty member appointed

Format of Annexures - I, II & III are enclosed along with this letter.

7. Now, therefore, the institution is hereby issued a conditional recognition under 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations for further necessary action as per the NCTE Rules & Regulations said above.

8. The institution is requested to submit the required information along with documentary proof duly certified by the concerned authority to SRC-NCTE for appraisal of the Southern Regional Committee.

9. It may be noted that the compliance along with details should be submitted to SRC-NCTE within 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter.

Admissions should not be made until unconditional letter of recognition is issued by Southern Regional Committee, NCTE.
