PREAMBLE:

M.A.S Subbaiah Chettiyar Educational & Charitable Trust, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for seeking grant of recognition in the name and style of Mass Teacher Training Institute, Chennai Salai, Kallapuliur Village, Kumbakonam-612501, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu for D.T.Ed-Additional intake course on 30.10.2008.

Application was processed and inspection of the institution was carried out on 13.03.2009. The inspection report was placed before SRC in its 172nd Meeting held on 25-26 March, 2009. After considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, SRC had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 16.04.2009 to the applicant institution under provision to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

Further, applicant institution had submitted the written representation on 01.05.2009. The said representation was considered by the SRC in its 175th Meeting held on 13-14 May, 2009 the committee decided to seek clarification. Accordingly, a clarification letter was issued to the institution on 29.05.2009. The institution submitted its reply on 17.06.2009. The reply was considered by SRC in its 177th Meeting held on 22-23 June, 2009 and SRC decided to issue letter of intent to the institution. Accordingly, a letter of intent was issued to the institution on 24.06.2009. The institution had submitted its reply on 02.07.2009 which was considered by SRC in its 178th Meeting held on 13-14 July, 2009 and SRC decided to issue notice. Accordingly, a notice was issued on 16.07.2009. The institution did not submit its written representation even after expiry of stipulated period. The matter was considered by SRC in its 180th Meeting held on 29 July, 2009 and SRC decided to issue notice to the institution to submit the reply before 17.08.2009.

Accordingly, a notice was issued to the institution on 31.07.2009. The institution submitted its reply on 19.08.2009. The reply was considered by SRC in its 181st Meeting held on 20-21 August, 2009 and SRC decided to issue notice to the institution to submit the reply before 28.08.2009.

Accordingly, a notice was issued to the institution on 24.08.2009. The institution did not submit reply even after expiry of stipulated period. The matter was placed before SRC in its 182nd Meeting held on 31st August, 2009 and SRC decided to refuse recognition/withdraw the Letter of intent or conditional Recognition to the said institution for D.T.Ed-AI course.

Accordingly, Conditional recognition given to the institution was withdrawn vide order.No.15838 dated. 24.09.2009.

Aggrieved by the withdrawn of CR letter of SRC, the applicant institution preferred an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, before NCTE, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority while considering the appeal passed an Order F.No.89-1308/2009 dated 12.02.2010 reverses the order appealed against

Further, the appellate authority order was placed before SRC in its 189th Meeting held on 25-26 February, 2010 and SRC decided to issue formal recognition order.

Hence the order.

ORDER


WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **M.A.S Subbaiah Chettiyar Educational & Charitable Trust, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE in the name of **Mass Teacher Training Institute, Chennai Salai, Kallapuliyur Village, Kumbakonam-612501, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu** for seeking grant of recognition for conducting **D.T.Ed-additional intake course on 30.10.2008.**

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **Elementary** teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Mass Teacher Training Institute, Chennai Salai, Kallapuliyur Village, Kumbakonam-612501, Thanjavur District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **D.T.Ed-Additional intake Course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **150(One Hundred and Fifty)** students which includes the existing intake of **100(Hundred)** students and an additional intake of **50(Fifty)** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter
 - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of Mass Teacher Training Institute, M.A.S. Subbaiah Chettiyar Educational & Charitable Trust, Kumbakonam, Tamilnadu dated 02/11/2009 is against the Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/2008-2009/15838 dated 24/09/2009 of the Southern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting D.T.Ed. course on the grounds "The institution has not appointed requisite faculty/faculty and also not submitted the faculty list and affidavits as per regulations 7(2) of NCTE."

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Mass Teacher Training Institute, M.A.S. Subbaiah Chettiyar Educational & Charitable Trust (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 06/11/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NGTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri S. Vijaya Kumar, Managing Trustee, Mass Teacher Training Institute, M.A.S. Subbaiah Chettiyar Educational & Charitable Trust, Kumbakonam, Tamilnadu presented the case of the appellant institution on 13.01.2010. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the appellant was given letter of intent prior to the grant of recognition by the SRC on 24-06-09. In compliance to this letter the appellant on 02-07-09 submitted the details regarding affidavits, list of faculty members, FDR for endowment fund and also the list of faculty already working as approved by the DTERT; Further SRC vide its letter dated 16-07-09 asked the appellant to submit the details of existing faculty, qualification certificate of faculty as well as the fixed deposit receipts in joint account for basic and additional intake of D.T.Ed. course, within a short span of 5 days i.e. by 21-7-09. The appellant received this letter itself on 22-07-09 and the appellant did reply to this letter but there was a marginal delay. It was also submitted that the appellant had requisite infrastructure and instructional facilities for both basic unit and additional units of D.Ed.


AND WHEREAS the Council noted that the appellant had been conducting D.Ed. with an intake of 100 (50 basic and 50 additional) and 11 Lecturers (5+6) were already approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai vide his letters dated 03-03-05 and 30-12-05. The appellant further appointed 3 Lecturers for the proposed additional unit of D.Ed. The Council observed that as per Regulations the number of full time teachers shall be increased by three for an additional intake of 50 students. It was also noted that the faculty was qualified as per norms. In view of the above the Council came to the conclusion that there was adequate justification in accepting the appeal for issuing a formal recognition order.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT report and after considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the

Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and set aside SRC's order dated 24-09-09 with direction to the SRC to grant formal recognition to the institution, within 15 days of issue of this order.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby confirms the Order appealed against.
