Sub : Extension of time duration to complete TET

Sir / Madam,


The NCTE had issued Guidelines for conducting Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) and the same was circulated to all the State Governments / UTs vide NCTE letter dated 11th February 2011.

Since the inception of TET, suggestions including from the CBSE and the Government of Karnataka have been received to increase the duration of time given to complete the TET by the candidates.

This matter was therefore, considered by the NCTE Committee in its 32nd meeting held on 8th March 2013, wherein the Committee decided to increase the time duration from 1.30 hours to 2.30 hours for a period of six months or till the report of the Committee constituted for this purpose is submitted and a decision taken thereon, whichever is earlier.

Accordingly, in view of the above, it is hereby intimated that the time duration as stipulated in clause 7 of NCTE Guidelines for conducting TET has been increased from 1.30 hours to 2.30 hours for a period of six months or till the report of the Committee constituted for the purpose is submitted and a decision taken thereon, whichever is earlier.
