PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education has been established under an Act of Parliament on 1st July 1995 with a view to achieve planned and coordinated development of teacher education and matters connected therewith, through the country. NCTE has 4 Regional Committee – Eastern, Western, Northern and Southern Regional Committee which are constituted by the Council of NCTE. Under the provisions of NCTE Regulation 2011 notified in 07.02.2011, 6 persons having special knowledge and experience in matters relating to teacher education shall be nominated members for a period of 2 years from the date of their nomination or till fresh appointment are made, whichever is later. The qualifications and experience given in clause 2 (2) of NCTE Regulation 2011 notified on 07.02.2011, is as follows :-

- a. *Former Vice-Chancellor, Pro-Vice Chancellors, Deans of the Faculties of Education if Universities of Central / State Government.*
- b. *Professors and Head of the Department of Education in the Universities under the Government Post Graduate Collages.*
- c. *Principals of Government Post Graduate Collages.*
- d. *Senior Teacher Educators, preferably of Government Institutions, with a minimum of 15 years' experience of teaching and research in education.*
- e. *Former Commissioners of Education, Former Directors of State Council of Education Research and Training (SCERT).*
- f. *Persons who have held a position not below the rank of Joint Secretary to the Government of India or Secretary in the State Government, dealing with education and related matters.*
- g. *Former Head of National level Institution in the field of education / teacher education.*

2. NCTE invites applications from persons, falling in the categories listed at Nos. (a) to (g) above, in the prescribed proforma, willing to be a member of the Regional Committee. The requisite resume duly filled in, and documents in support of qualification and experience may be submitted through online mode only at www.ncte.gov.in/Website/RCM.aspx, for consideration by the Selection Committee, within 30 days of the issue of this Public Notice on NCTE website.

3. Persons employed in any Government/Semi-Govt/Autonomous Body/Statutory Body/PSU should forward their application for nomination through proper channel only. The same should be received in NCTE on/before the last date specified above.
