ORDER

I. GROUNDS OF WITHDRAWAL

The appeal of Indira Gandhi Training College, 83/3, Nellikuzhi, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam, Kerala-688691 dated 04.01.2022 filed under Section 18 of NCTE Act. 1993 is against the Order No. 404 meeting held on 16th&17th November, 2021 Minutes Based APSO0576 dated 16.11.2021 of the Southern Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting B.Ed. Course on the grounds that "The institution has submitted BCC but not in prescribed format and not approved by competent authority. 2. The building plan is not approved by competent authority. Moreover, no detail is available about separate toilet facility for male and female and PWD. 3. The document at the time of recognition submitted Notarized Sale Deed, Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Survey No. 83/3, 83/4A, 84/5, 83/5-C, 83/4-8, 84/5, 84/7 situated at ERAMALLOR Village and at present land documents submitted as Notarized Sale Deed, Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Survey No. 3539/9B/4, 353/7/1A, 359/8, 359/9A, 359/9B/2/11. 358/1A/17, 359/9B/3/12, 359/10, 358/1A/17, situated at ERAMALLOR village are different Change of land and premise without prior permission of NCTE is not permissible under NCTE Regulation."

II. SUBMISSIONS MADE BY APPELLANT: -

Sh. Dr. K.P. Shiyas, General Secretary, Indira Gandhi Training College, 83/3, Nellikuzhi, Kothamangalam, Ernakulam, Kerala-686691 appeared online to present the case of the appellant institution on 02.09.2022. In the appeal it is submitted that institution has all the essential documents and attached a Copy of Judgement dated 12.07.2022 filed in W.P. 22081 of 2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam.

III. OUTCOME OF THE CASE

Appeal Committee perused the relevant records and the documents submitted by appellant institution. The earlier Appeal was disposed of by the Appellate Authority vide Order dated 18.04.2022.

Aggrieved by the said appellate order dated 18.04.2022, the appellant institution (petitioner) filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 22081 of 2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Emakulam. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 12.07.2022 directed as under:

"Direction to the Appellate Authority to reconsider the matter, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and adverting to all documents produced or to be produced by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today; with liberty being reserved to them to call for any further documents or input, which shall be acceded to by the petitioner; thus culminating is an appropriate order and necessary action thereon as expeditiously as is possible but not later than one month from the date of receipt of a copy this judgement."

The Appellant institution vide letter dated 18.07.2022 has submitted the following documents with a request to consider it as a compliance of deficiencies pointed out in impugned Withdrawal Order dated 29.12.2021.

a) The institution has submitted BCC in prescribed format and approved by competent authority.

b) Revised building plan submitted approved by competent authority. The plan consists

separate toilet facility for male and female and PWD duly mentioned.

c) Resubmitted Notarized Sale Deed, Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Survey No. 83/3, 83/4A, 84/5, 83/5-C, 83/4-8, 84/5, 84/7 situated at ERAMALLOR Village. Trust purchased additional land in Survey No. 3539/9B/4, 353/7/1A, 359/8, 359/9A, 359/9B/2/11. 358/1A/17, 359/9B/3/12, 359/10, 358/1A/17, situated at ERAMALLOR village for the development works.

Noting the submissions and oral arguments advanced during the hearing by the appellant institution on 02.09.2022, the Appeal Committee observed that the building completion certificate is not approved by the Competent Authority and since the institution is situated in the rural area there is no seal of gram panchayat in column 4 of BCC. The building plan submitted is also not approved by the Competent Authority. The Appeal Committee noted that SRC was justified in withdrawing recognition of the appellant institution on grounds of the aforesaid deficiencies and the appellant institution has failed to rectify the deficiencies.

In these circumstances, the Appeal Committee concluded that the instant appeal deserved to be rejected and therefore the impugned order of SRC is confirmed.

IV. DECISION: -

After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded that the instant appeal deserved to be rejected and therefore the impugned order of SRC is confirmed.

GROUNDS OF WITHDRAWAL

The appeal of Grace College of Education, 231/2, 232/2A, Nedungunam, Vandavasi Road, Chetpet, Tiruvannamalai, Tamilnadu-606807 dated 02.12.2021 filed under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 is against the Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07706/M.Ed./{TN}/2021/128724 dated 06.10.2021 of the Southern Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting M.Ed. Course on the grounds that "Vide last reminder letter dated 06.11.2020 the institution was directed to submit the latest staff for both B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses as previously the proforma of faculty was not having date of approval. Vide its letter dated 23.11.2020 the institution had submitted a copy of letter dated 05.07.2017 issued by the Registrar, TTEU regarding approval of only 2 Assistant Professors for Pedagogy subjects. The proforma of these 2-faculty submitted but that is also not having date of approval. The institution failed to submit latest staff list approved by the affiliating body."

The Representative, Grace College of Education, 231/2, 232/2A, Nedungunam, Vandavasi Road, Chetpet, Tiruvannamalai, Tamilnadu-606807 appeared online to present the case of the appellant institution on 02.09.2022. In the appeal it is submitted that institution has all the essential documents and attached a copy of Judgement dated 12.07.2022 filed in W.P. 10465/2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.

III. OUTCOME OF THE CASE

Appeal Committee perused the relevant records and the documents submitted by appellant institution. The earlier Appeal was disposed of by the Appellate Authority vide Order dated 18.04.2022.

Aggrieved by the said appellate order dated 18.04.2022, the appellant institution (petitioner) filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 10465 of 2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 12.07.2022 directed as under:

"Thus, in the interest of justice and in light of the position taken by coordinate benches of this Court, the order dated 18th April, 2022 passed by the Appellate Authority is set-aside and the matter is remanded back to the Appellate Authority. The matter be remanded back to the Appellate Authority. which shall now, taking into consideration subsequent developments, and in particular, the list of faculty members dated 13th December 2021 (annexed as Annexure P-4 to the present petition), with a period of three weeks from today and shall take a decision thereon in accordance with law."

The Appellant institution vide letter dated 21.07.2022 has submitted the following documents with a request to consider it as a compliance of deficiencies pointed out in impugned Withdrawal Order dated 06.10.2021: -

Noting the submissions and oral arguments advanced during the hearing by the appellant institution, on 02.09.2022, the Appeal Committee observed that the faculty appointed were not NET qualified and the representative of the institution submitted that there is a typographical error in the qualifications mentioned in the faculty list. Therefore, revised faculty list shall be submitted.

The Appeal Committee as per extant appeal rules decided to grant another (Second) opportunity to appellant institution to present its case before Appellate Authority with the revised faculty list.

GROUNDS OF WITHDRAWAL

The appeal of Dr. M.R. Reddy College of Education, Parkal, Bhupally Road Parkal, Warangal, Telangana-506164 dated 15.09.2021 filed under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 is against the Order No. SRO/NCTE/APPSO0044/B.Ed./ {TS}/2021/127599-7606 dated 28.07.2021 of the Southern Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting B.Ed. Course on the grounds that At the time of recognition submitted a copy of sale deed dated 27.03.1998. In response to FSCN the Institution submitted Deed of gift settlement deed dated 17.11.2015 Both the land documents are different, and the Institution failed to submit satisfactory Explanation. The Institution has submitted new CLU at time of submitted of RPRO. The Institution has submitted photocopy of Building Plan, but the stamps and signature of Approving Authority are not Legible. Moreover the total built up area is not mentioned in building plan. As per the building plan, the size of multipurpose hall is shown as 1350 Sq.Ft. which is less than 2000 Sq.Ft. required under NCTE Regulations not appointed faculty of performing Arts, Health and Physical Education and fine arts."

SUBMISSIONS MADE BY APPELLANT: -11.

Sri Rasheed Ahmed Pasha, Academic Co-Ordinator, Dr. M.R. Reddy College of Education, Parkal, Bhupally Road Parkal, Warangal, Telangana-506164 appeared online to present the case of the appellant institution on 02.09.2022. In the appeal memoranda it is submitted that institution has all the essential documents and attached a Copy of Judgement dated 26.07.2022 filed in W.P. 31252 of 2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana at Hyderabad.

OUTCOME OF THE CASE III.

Appeal Committee perused the relevant records and the documents submitted by appellant institution. The earlier appeal was disposed of by the Appellate Authority vide Order dated 26.11.2021.

Aggrieved by the said appellate order dated 26.11.2021, the appellant institution (petitioner) filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 31252 of 2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana at Hyderabad. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 26.07.2022 directed as under:

"According to this Court, there is no consideration of all the grounds raised and documents submitted by the petitioner herein in the impugned order dated 28.07.2021. Moreover, in the impugned order the 3rd respondent had mentioned the date of the order passed by the 2nd respondent as 20.01.2020 instead of 28.07.2021. Therefore, the impugned order is not a reasoned order, and it is nullity.

Therefore, without going into the merits and demerits of the case, the order dated 26.11.2021 passed by the 3rd respondent is set aside and accordingly, this Writ Petition is allowed. The matter is remanded back to 3rd respondent with a direction to pass appropriate order in accordance with law considering all the grounds raised and documents filed by the petitioner herein in statutory appeal and pass a reasoned order. The 3d respondent shall complete the said exercise within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed."

In the circumstances, Appeal Committee concluded that the case deserved to be remanded back to the SRC with the direction to consider all the relevant documents submitted by the appellant institution and take further appropriate action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.

IV. <u>DECISION</u>: -

After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded that the instant appeal deserved remanded back to the SRC with the direction to consider all the relevant documents submitted by the appellant institution and take further appropriate action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.

Aggrieved by the said appellate order dated 26.05.2022, the appellant institution (petitioner) filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 11282 of 2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 29.07.2022 directed as under:

"As the said documents were also placed on record before the Appellate Committee but were not taken into consideration, in the interest of justice and in light of the position taken by co-ordinate benches of this Court, the order dated 26th May, 2022 passed by the Appellate Authority is set-aside, and the matter is remanded back to the Appellate Authority, which shall now decide the same, taking into consideration subsequent developments, and in particular, the documents which were enclosed with the appeal report by Petitioner-institute, within a period of two weeks from the date of uploading of this order in accordance with law.

Needless to say, the Appellate Committee shall examine the merits of the case uninfluenced by any of the observations made hereinabove.

As the withdrawal order is of 07th January, 2022, in terms of second provision to Section 17(1) of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, the withdrawal order will take effect from the end of academic session 2022-23. "On the las date, after some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners had concerned that the petitioners will be availing their remedy of appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act for assailing the impugned withdrawal order dated 25.03.2022. He had however prayed that the respondent no. 2 be directed to clarify that the impugned withdrawal order will come into force only with effect from the academic session 2023-2024. In the light of limited prayer of the petitioner, learned counsel for the respondents were granted time to obtain instructions.

Today, Ms. Kaul submits that in view of the second provision to Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, the impugned withdrawal order will come into force only from the academic session following the issuance of the withdrawal order, as a consequence the impugned order will not affect the rights of the petitioner for the academic session 2022-23 and will only come

Aggrieved by the said appellate order dated 26.05.2022, the appellant institution (petitioner) filed a Writ Petition (C) No. 11450 of 2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The Hon'ble Court by its order dated 02.08.2022 directed as under:

"Needless to say, the Appellate Committee shall examine the merits of the case uninfluenced by any of the observations made hereinabove. As the withdrawal order is 2nd November, 2021, in terms of second proviso to Section 17(1) of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, the withdrawal order will take effect from the ned of academic session 2022-23. Therefore, the Petitioner would be entitled to take admissions with respect to the academic session 2022-23. The Respondent shall send an intimation to this effect to the Affiliating University and update the portal within a period of one week from today. With the above directions, the petition is disposed of, along with other pending application(s)."

The Appellant institution vide letter dated 25.08.2022 has submitted the Hon'ble Court order dated 02.08.2022 with a request to consider it as a compliance of deficiencies pointed out in impugned Withdrawal Order dated 21.11.2021.

Noting the submissions and oral arguments advanced during the hearing by the Appellant institution on 02.09.2022 observed that the institution has submitted requisite list of faculty duly approved by the affiliating university and other relevant documents.

In these circumstances, the Appeal Committee concluded that the matter is remanded back to SRC for consideration and take appropriate action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.

III. DECISION: -

After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded that the instant appeal deserved remanded back to the SRC with the direction to consider all the relevant documents submitted by the appellant institution and take further appropriate action as per NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.

The above decision is being communicated on behalf of the Appeal Committee.
