CHAPTER 1

NCTE: At A Glance

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) was established as a statutory body by an Act of Parliament (Act No. 73 of 1993) with a view to achieving planned and coordinated development of teacher education throughout the country, the regulation and proper maintenance of norms and standards in the teacher education system and for matters connected therewith. The NCTE Act came into force w.e.f. 1st July 1995 and the NCTE came into existence on 17th August 1995 with its Head Office in New Delhi. The Council is the highest decision making body of NCTE consisting of 43 Members comprising the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Member Secretary on full time basis besides the Education Secretary of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, Adviser (Education), Planning Commission, Education Secretaries of the State Governments, Members of Parliament, eminent academicians and Heads of National Educational Institutions like NCERT, NIEPA, UGC, CBSE, AICTE. The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Member Secretary are appointed by the Gol. The NCTE is headed by the Chairperson who is vested with executive powers and, along with the Regional Committees, is responsible for implementing the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations made thereunder, and also the policy decisions of the Council taken from time to time.

- 2. As per Section 20 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the 4 Regional Committees i.e. Eastern, Western, Northern and Southern deal with matters related to grant of recognition / permission to the TEIs under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act in the States/UTs under their jurisdiction. The RCs receive applications from the applicant institutions for starting a new teacher education programme or for introduction of another teacher education programme in an existing TEIs or for additional intake in an existing teacher education programme under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act. The RCs also exercise powers to withdraw recognition/permission of a recognized institution under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, provided it is established that the concerned institution has contravened the provisions of the NCTE Act / Rules / Regulations under which recognition/permission was granted to it. The RCs, beside the functions under Section 14, 15 and 17 of the NCTE Act, perform such other functions as may be assigned to it by the Council or as may be determined by Regulations.
- 3. The offices of the RCs are presently located at Plot No. G-7, Dwarka, Sector 10, New Delhi. The ERC which was located at Bhubaneswar, Odisha was shifted to New Delhi on 06th October 2021. Each RC comprises of a Chairperson, eminent educationists and administrators & Education Secretaries of the Education Departments of the State Governments/UTs located under their Region. The Regional Director, a full-time officer of the NCTE, functions as Executive Head of the Regional office as well as acts as Convener of the RC meetings.
- 4. The grant of recognition/ permission/ withdrawal to a Teacher Education Institution or a Teacher Education Program are looked after by the four Regional Committees of NCTE which cover the following States/UTs under their jurisdiction:
 - Eastern Regional Committee: Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, West Bengal.
 - Western Regional Committee: Goa, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu.
 - Northern Regional Committee: Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Chandigarh, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.
 - Southern Regional Committee: Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Lakshadweep, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Puducherry.

- 5. The Academic Division carries out various tasks related to the curricular aspects of various teacher education programmes. The Regulation Division formulates Regulations, policy matters and also minimum qualification for appointment for teachers in schools. The Inspection Division conducts inspection of recognized TEIs under Section 13 of the NCTE Act. The Appeal Division functions as the Secretariat for the Appeal Committee to whom the TEIs, aggrieved with decision of the RCs, can file an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993. The Legal Division looks after the various legal matters of NCTE headquarters and coordinates with the legal section of the RCs on legal matters. The IT & e-Governance Division manages the NCTE website and the IT modules along with mobile applications. The Coordination Division functions as the Nodal Division for collation of data/reports/communications from various divisions to be sent to other organizations/ MoE etc. The RTI Division deals with applications received under the RTI Act 2005. The Rajbhasha Division carries out various function to promote the use of Hindi and implementation of the Official Language Act, 1963. The Vigilance Division looks after preventive and punitive Vigilance in the organisation in line with the Central Vigilance Commission Guidelines. The Administrative Division carries out the responsibilities related to general administration. The Accounts Division maintains day to day accounts of NCTE and looks after the financial and budgetary aspects. The VIP Division looks after correspondence/ references received from VIPs to be taken on priorities.



CHAPTER 2

Major Initiatives and Achievements (Division-wise Details)

(i) Academic Division

• The Hon'ble Union Minister of Education, Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' launched the "MYNEP2020" Web Portal on 1st April, 2021 to invite suggestions / inputs/membership from the stakeholders for preparing draft for development of National Professional Standards for Teachers and National Mission for Mentoring Programme Membership. The "MyNEP2020" Platform was operational from 1st April, 2021 to 10thJune, 2021. NCTE has received an overwhelming response to MyNEP2020 Portal with over 2500 and 1900 responses received in NPST and NMM respectively from various stakeholders.



- A webinar on "National Professional Standards for Teachers" National Education Policy, 2020" was held on 25th May, 2021 virtually. Many stakeholders participants participated in the webinar.
- A National Webinar on NPST was conducted by the NRC of NCTE on 3rd June, 2021 wherein experts in the field of teacher education participated.
- On 29th July, 2021, NCTE officers and officials listened, vide online mode, to the address of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India wherein multiple initiatives were launched on the completion of one year of National Education Policy, 2020 in order to transform the education sector in a New India.

- A National Webinar was conducted on 6th August, 2021, on "Quality Education, Accreditation & Teacher Development", celebrating one year of completion of NEP2020 by NCTE, along with UGC and AICTE. The Chief Guest for the Webinar was Dr. Jitendra Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. The Webinar was a great success with viewership of about 23000.
- A Webinar was organized on 9th August, 2021 on the theme "Professional Standard of 21st Century Teacher" on the occasion of completion of one year of NEP 2020. A brain-storming session to enlighten the Teacher Education community was the purpose of this Webinar. Around 5152 participants took part in the webinar.
- A team of NCTE led by Member Secretary, NCTE visited Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar, Gujarat on 24th August, 2021 to understand the ITEP programme which is being run by the institution since its inception in 2011. This was a very fruitful exercise leading to various insights on different facets of NEP 2020.







 Shri Santosh Sarangi IAS, Chairperson NCTE, Ms. Kesang Y. Sherpa IRS, Member Secretary NCTE alongwith other officers visited Centre for Command and Control, Gandhinagar, Gujrat on 25th August, 2021. This is a state of the art facility in the country, pioneering the technological advancements in the field of education.





• The Chairperson, NCTE along with the NCTE team visited Children's University, Gandhinagar on 25th August, 2021 to understand the traditional values and systems that were being imparted for the all round development of the child.

National Mission for Mentoring (NMM)

NMM, as envisaged in Para 15.11 of NEP 2020, talks about the creation of a large pool of outstanding senior/retired professionals willing to provide mentoring to school teachers. These potential mentors, regardless of the age or position of the mentor and mentee, will contribute towards realizing 21st century developmental goals of our nation. The NMM underlines the importance of the short and long-term mentoring/professional support. It brings an opportunity to leverage cross learning amongst different individuals leading to their continuous professional development. An initial document 'Bluebook on NMM' is in public domain to gather inputs and suggestions from various stakeholders. Further NMM will be piloted in 30 Central Schools (15 KV. 10 JNVS & 5 CBSE schools).

Open House Discussions on NMM

- For having a bottom- up approach, a series of 15 Open house discussions were organised across the country to gather the inputs/suggestions on preliminary draft on NMM.
- Discussions were conducted in both physical and hybrid mode across 15 different places throughout the country.
- Various stakeholders including teachers, teacher educators, school leaders, faculty DIETs' and SCERTs participated in this open house discussions.





National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST)

National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST) - A Guiding Document has been prepared in compliance with para 5.20 of NEP 2020 for piloting in controlled manner. NPST is a public statement of what constitutes teacher quality. It defines the work of teachers and makes explicit elements of high-quality, effective teaching in 21st century schools that will improve educational outcomes for students. It will govern the teaching profession in the country in relation to its professional role. In addition, NPST will aim to improve the teachers' personal and professional development by providing them an understanding of what is expected in terms of their performance and what needs to be done to enhance the same. 15 Open House Discussions with academicians, educational administrators, teacher educators, HoDs, SCERTs, DIETs, Principals, Teachers (Public/Private), NGOs, other Stakeholders were conducted across the country to gather the inputs/ideas on preliminary draft on NPST from the ground level functionaries as a bottom-up approach.

Glimpses of Open House Discussions on NPST





 A team of NCTE led by Chairperson NCTE visited the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai on 16th November 2021 for discussion on the ongoing developments in the field of teacher education by TISS. He also inaugurated the Centre for Excellence in Teacher Education, TISS.



 Chairperson, NCTE spoke about the 4 Year ITEP, which is a dual degree undergraduate course, at the North-East Education Conclave 2021 at Guwahati on 20th November, 2021.



 NCTE team led by Member Secretary, NCTE visited Osmania University, Telangana on 22nd November, 2021 as part of the series of National Consultation on NEP 2020, curriculum and challenges for teacher education.



• An Expert Committee was formed by MoE in January 2022 to finalise the curriculum framework for 4 Year ITEP course which was submitted by NCTE to MoE. Regular meetings of this committee are ongoing.





A joint deliberation on NEP 2020 was held in CBSE office on 2nd February, 2022 wherein NCTE presented the implementation strategies of NPST and NMM. The meeting was attended by Shri Manoj Ahuja, IAS, Chairperson, NCTE & Chairman CBSE, Commissioner KVS, Commission JNV and Member Secretary NCTE along with other officers.



 Member Secretary, NCTE along with her team visited Auroville, Puducherry on 6th March, 2022 to understand the component of experiential learning which has been espoused by NEP 2020.



• Dr. Harshad Patel, Vice-Chancellor, Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar, Gujarat along with his faculty and students visited NCTE office on 14th March, 2022 as part of their internship programme. They were given presentation on the various ongoing tasks by the NEP Cell of NCTE. It was noteworthy as this was the first time that an institution was visiting NCTE.



(ii) Appeal Division

In terms of the provisions of section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993, TEIs aggrieved by the orders issued by the RCs under section 14, 15 and 17 of the Act, can prefer appeals in the prescribed form to the Appeal Committee within 60 days of issue of such orders along with the prescribed fee and with the memorandum of appeal. On receipt of a memorandum of appeal, the Appeal Committee considers the appeal filed and after giving the appellant a reasonable opportunity of being heard, passes such orders as it may deem fit. The Appeal Committee has to dispose off every appeal within a period of 3 months from the date of its filling.

During this period, the Appeal Committee held 14 meetings and a total number of 368 appeals were heard, out of which 282 appeals were disposed off.

(iii) Inspection Division

Section 13 of the NCTE Act, 1993 provides for inspection of recognised teacher education institutions for the purposes of ascertaining whether the recognised institutions are functioning in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations made there under. The inspection of a TEI is conducted in the manner prescribed under the NCTE Rules and Visiting Team Manual. Thereafter the Inspection Division forwards the Inspection Report to the RCs for action at their end. During this period, 65 inspections under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993 were conducted.

(iv) IT & E-Governance Division

The IT & e-Governance Section has undertaken several activities during the period reported hereunder. Most of these activities were launched during the year of which some are likely to be completed shortly. These activities are as follows:

Revamping of NCTE Website

NCTE launched its revamped website on the occasion of its Foundation Day on 17th August, 2021. This new website is interactive, aesthetic, informative, disabled friendly and adhering to the various norms of GoI.




Performance Appraisal Report System (PAR):

PAR portal has been created inhouse to receive the information of the existing TEIs recognized by NCTE. This is a mechanism to analyze the quality parameters of TEIs. All existing TEIs had to fill the online PAR proforma for 2020-21 till 2nd April, 2022. Immense effort was put in to customize the PAR proforma to make it more relevant, reduce human interface and more effective by removing unwanted information sought and introducing fool proof features such as geotagging, georeferencing, alerts in case of duplication of PAN of faculty members etc. A mobile app called "PAR NCTE" was developed which was also linked to the online portal of PAR on the NCTE website.



4 Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) has been prepared in compliance with para 15.5 of NEP 2020, for piloting in multi disciplinary institutions. This program aims at preparing teachers for Foundational, Preparatory, Middle and Secondary stages as per the new school structure of NEP2020. It will ensure that outstanding students enter the teaching profession. A student undergoing this course will be grounded in Indian values, languages, knowledge, ethos, tribal tradition and also well versed in latest advances in education and pedagogy. This course caters to the need of 21st Century skills.





Ministry of Education notifies Four Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme

Ministry of Education notifies the Four Year ITEP, a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree offering B.A. B.Ed./ B. Sc. B. Ed. and B.Com. B.Ed. which is one of the major mandates of the National Education Policy 2020 related to Teacher Education.As per the NEP, 2020, teacher engagement from the year 2030 onwards will be only through ITEP. It will be offered in pilot mode initially in about 50 selected multidisciplinary institutions across the country.

National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) under Ministry of Education has devised the curriculum of this course in such a way that it enables a student-teacher to get a degree in education as well as a specialised discipline such as history, mathematics, science, arts, economics, or commerce. ITEP will not only impart cutting-edge pedagogy, but will also establish a foundation in early childhood care and education (ECCE), foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN), inclusive education, and an understanding of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, among others. The Year ITEP will be available for all students who choose teaching as a profession after secondary, by choice. This integrated course will benefit students since they will save one year by finishing it in four years rather than the customary five years required by the present B.Ed. plan. The commencement of Four Year ITEP will be from the academic session 2022-23. Admission for the same will be carried out by the National Testing Agency (NTA) through the National Common Entrance Test (NCET). This course will be offered by multidisciplinary institutions and become as the minimal degree qualification for schoolteachers.

The Four Year ITEP is a milestone achievement in fulfilling one of the major mandates of National Education Policy 2020. The course will contribute substantially to the revitalization of the whole teacher education sector. The prospective teachers passing out of this course through a multidisciplinary environment, grounded in Indian values and traditions will be instilled with the needs of 21st century on global standards, and hence will be largely helpful in shaping the future of New India.

(v) Vigilance Division

In order to create awareness and to sensitize the work force of NCTE on the need and importance of the fight against corruption, the "Vigilance Awareness Week 2021" was observed in NCTE from 26th October to 1st November 2021, as per the directives of Central Vigilance Commission Circular No. 021/VGL/045 dated 01/09/2021 with the theme "Independent India @75: Self Reliance with Integrity". Various activities such as Spot Essay Writing competition, lecture on 'Sensitisation regarding eradication of corruption and Preventive Vigilance Measures' were organized with the aim of spreading awareness and sensitizing the officers/officials. On 26th October 2021, the inauguration of the Vigilance Awareness Week 2021 was marked by takingthe Integrity Pledge at the NCTE Hqrs.



(f) Regulation Section

- PAR after its advent on 22nd September, 2019 was challenged in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. A number of TEIs approached the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 11304/2019 and obtained stay thereon, along with directions to not take any coercive measures against the TEIs till disposal of the petition. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi pronounced the Judgment in this case on dated 27th May, 2021 upholding the decision of NCTE requiring the TEIs to file PAR. In view of this decision, NCTE came out with a public notice on 30th September, 2021 as per which PAR is required to be mandatorily submitted online by all TEIs on the NCTE portal for academic session 2020-2021. Hon'ble Supreme Court has upheld the decision to file PAR, vide order of SLP(C) No. 5479/2022. The last date for filing of PAR by all TEIs was 2nd April 2022 for academic session 2020-2021. 10966 TEIs have filed PAR. PAR will enable NCTE to make a detailed analysis of all TEIs for further action, wherever necessary. In order to make PAR fool-proof, several features such as geotagging, geo referencing, alerts in case of duplicate faculty members, images of various mandatory items, adoption of fully online procedure with no human interface etc. have been incorporated in the PAR portal.
- The validity period of Teachers Eligibility Test qualifying certificate was increased from 7 years to lifetime with retrospective effective from 2011 on 9th June, 2021 unless otherwise notified by the appropriate government. This is a positive step in increasing the employment opportunity for candidates aspiring to make a career in the teaching field.



Union Education Minister Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' announced that Government has decided to extend the validity period of Teachers Eligibility Test qualifying certificate from 7 years to lifetime with retrospective effect from 2011. The respective State Govts. /UTs will take necessary action to revalidate/issue fresh TET certificates to those candidates whose period of 7 years has already elapsed, he added.

Shri Pokhriyal said this will be a positive step in increasing the employment opportunities for candidates aspiring to make a career in the teaching field.



Teachers Eligibility Test is one of the essential qualifications for a person to be eligible for appointment as a teacher in schools. The Guidelines dated 11th February 2011 of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) laid down that TET would be conducted by the State Governments and the validity of the TET Certificate was 7 years from the date of passing TET.

- Vide Govt. of India Gazette Notifications dated 14th October, 2021, NCTE incorporated "3-year Integrated B.Ed.-M.Ed. Degree" as a minimum qualification for a person to be eligible for appointment as a school teacher. Accordingly, Regulation 2014 was also amended to bring this into effect.
- Member Secretary, NCTE has conducted a physical meeting with the Member Secretary, Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) on 21st October, 2021 for initiating the process for signing of MoU for development of curriculum for Special Education align with ITEP & NEP 2020.






- The National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedures) Amendment Regulations, 2021 dated 22nd October, 2021 were published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part III, Section 4, vide Notification No. File No: NCTE-Reg1011/80/2018-MS(Regulation)-HQ, dated the 26th October, 2021; thereby laying down the Norms & Standards in respect of Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), a dual-major holistic bachelor degree offering B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.Com. B.Ed., as mandated in the NEP 2020.
- A sensitization/training programme for filing PAR was conducted in online mode on 11th November, 2021 wherein 588 TEIs from across the country participated.
- Member Secretary, NCTE participated in the meeting of 'Inter-Ministerial Committee' constituted by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment to look into the suggestions made by Jawad Abidi Foundation to make digital education inclusive of persons with disabilities on 25th February, 2022. A sub-committee was formed under the Chairpersonship of Member Secretary NCTE to look into the recommendations for the suggestions related to teacher education sector.




