ORDER

WHEREAS, the Institution, namely, American Institute, 34/1 & 2 (New 33 'A') Yusuf Sarai, Green Park, New Delhi - 16, vide its covering letter dated 30.12.2003, has made application to the Northern Regional Committee (NRC), Jaipur for grant of recognition of the NTT Programme from academic session 2006-2007 with an annual intake of 50 seats, having Shri Peeru Singh Educational Welfare Society, New Delhi as its Managing Society. Since, the Institution did not submit essential documents as required by Regulations, 2002, the NRC vide its communication dated 18th /20th April 2006 intimated to the institution that the deficiencies mentioned may be removed and intimated to this office with relevant documents within 90 days from the date of issue of the letter.

AND WHEREAS, in reply to the deficiency letter, the institution submitted a representation dated 12th June 2006, alongwith a rectification deed dated 15th May 2006 and regarding Building Plan, the Institution has submitted a Certificate from Prof. Kiran Walia, Chairperson, Delhi Commission for women that the said property lies in a Lal Dora Area.

AND WHEREAS, the NRC in its 105th meeting held on 28th-30th July 06, having considered the entire matter and being satisfied that the Institution did not fulfil the essential requirements prescribed as per NCTE Regulations for starting the NTT course, decided to reject the application submitted by the Institution for NTT course.

AND THEREFORE, in terms of the above decision of NRC, the above application of the institution seeking recognition of the institution, American Institute, 34/1 & 2 (New 33 'A'), Yusuf Sarai, Green Park, New delhi - 16 to start NTT Course is rejected under section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act 1993.

Consequently, the above institution shall not admit any student in NTT course and the examining body shall not grant affiliation and also shall not hold examination, whether provisional or otherwise for the NTT course if conducted by the Institution unless the said institution is granted recognition / permission for the said course by the NRC-NCTE.

In accordance with section 17 (4) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education, namely NTT course, obtained pursuant to such course or training in the above institution shall not be treated as valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by this order, it can prefer an appeal before National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi – 110 002 against this order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, within 60 days of the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for appeal are enclosed herewith.
