WHEREAS AHIRWAL SEWA TRUST, 120, CIVIL LINES, GURGAON, HARYANA had applied for grant of recognition /permission (apn06474) for D.Ed. course of two years duration under section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the NRC NCTE on 31.3.2008.

- AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution and the visiting team which visited the institution on 27.4.2008 has since submitted its report.
- AND WHEREAS, in its 129th meeting held on 7th -9th May 2008 the Northern Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team, perusal of videography as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, was satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 24.5.2008 to the applicant institution under proviso to section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993 thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.
- AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution had submitted representation dated 21.7.2008 to NRC, NCTE. The said representation of the institution as well as other documents and materials submitted by the institution along with VTR and videography were again duly considered by the Northern Regional Committee on 28-31 July 2008, which came to the conclusion that recognition/permission to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:
 - The offer letter issued by the Estate Officer, HUDA, Gurgaon states the total land offered is 0.23 Acre whereas the Possession Certificate submitted by the institution stated the total land as 1588.87 sqm.
 - Along with the application form and also to the inspection team, the institution had (ii) submitted the building plan approved for the purpose of church. In reply to the show cause notice, the institution had submitted the building plan on the same land which has been recommended for sanction with regard to this, the committee noted the following: (a) How come one building can be approved for two purposes. (b) The building plan is not yet approved, it is only recommended for sanction.
- The institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqrs under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993. The appeal order F. No. 89-285/2008-Appeal/85621 dated 14.10.2008 given direction as under: "AND WHEREAS, after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council felt that there was enough ground to accept the appeal and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order reversed with direction to the NRC to issue recognition to the institution.

- 6. NOW, THEREFORE, Appeal order F. No. 89-285/2008-Appeal /85621 dated 14.10.2008 and in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to CAMBRIDGE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, PLOT NO. 16, SECTOR -10-A, GURGAON, HARYANA for conducting D.Ed. Course of Elementary (level) of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) students from the academic session 2008-2009 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - (i) The admission in the institutions so recognized for the academic session 2008-2009 shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body, before the commencement of the academic year and the admission of the students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic year 2008-2009, failing which the recognition will be deemed to be for the next academic year i.e. 2009-2010.
 - (ii) Formal orders for recognition/permission will operate for 2008-2009 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session would be fulfilled as per calendar of the University/affiliating body. The decision of the University in this regard shall be final.
 - (iii) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
 - (iv) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - (v) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.
- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
- 7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff.
- 8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

- 9. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:
 - Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
