ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Gurudham College of Education, Khedar, 6th K.M. Stone, Hisar Road, NH-65, The-Barwala, Distt-Hisar, Haryana (HR-1736) had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.Ed. Course of one year** duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred only) on 25.7.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the Northern Regional Committee in its 140th Meeting held from 25th to 26th April, 2009 the file of the institution was closed vide NRC's order dated 12th May, 2009.

AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal against the said order. The Appellate Authority confirmed the order appealed against vide its order dated 7.8.2009.

4. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the Northern Regional Committee in its 152nd Meeting held from 23rd to 25th November, 2009 and the Committee decided to implement the orders of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed in W.P.No.18.5.2009 & 13802 of 2009. Accordingly a letter to the institution was issued on 7th December, 2009.

5. AND WHEREAS the inspection of the institution was conducted on 2.2.2010. The matter was placed before the Northern Regional Committee in its 157th Meeting held from 24th to 27th March, 2010 and the Committee decided to issue letter under clause 7(9) of Regulations 2007. Accordingly the Letter of Intent Prior to Recognition under clause 7(9) was issued on 2.4.2010.

6. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the Northern Regional Committee in its 159th Meeting held from 28th April to 1st May, 2010 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly the Show Cause Notice was issued on 13.5.2010.

7. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed before the Northern Regional Committee in its 160th Meeting held from 18th May, to 20th May, 2010 and the Committee decided to refuse the recognition to B.Ed. course. Accordingly the Refusal Order was issued on 10.6.2010.

8. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal against the said order on 8.7.2010 and after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, VT Report, affidavit and after considering oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was enough ground to accept the appeal and that it should be accepted. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted and NRC's order dated 10.06.2010 was reversed with a direction to the NRC to issue formal recognition order under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations.

9]. AND WHEREAS as per clarification received from NCTE, New Delhi vide letter No.48-6/PT-III/NCTE/(N&S) dated 31.8.2010 the Northern Regional Committee in its 166th Meeting held on 9th September, 2010 decided that the recognition order under section 7 (11) of NCTE, Regulations, and letter of intent prior to the recognition under section 7 (9) of NCTE, Regulations, in all such pending cases where NRC or Council (NCTE) had decided to grant recognition under section 7 (11) or 7 (9) of NCTE, Regulations be issued from the session 2010-2011 subject to the following condition:-

- i) The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010 -2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.
- ii) Formal orders for recognition /permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

10. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Gurudham College of Education, Khedar, 6th K.M. Stone, Hisar Road, NH-65, The-Barwala, Distt-Hisar, Haryana (HR-1736)** of one year duration with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred) Students** under **clause 7(11)** of NCTE Regulations on the following conditions-

- I) **The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010 -2011 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.**
- II) **Formal orders for recognition /permission will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 180 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.**
- III) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- IV) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- V) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations.

11. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.


13. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

14. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

15. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, the institution must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
