WHEREAS in terms of Section <u>14(1)</u> of the NCTE Act, 1993 Pratap College of Education, VPO- Jundia, Distt- Karnal, Haryana, (HR- 1650) has submitted an application (Code No. APN06816) to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting <u>B.Ed.</u> Course of <u>one year</u> duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred only) students on 30.04.2008.

- AND WHEREAS the competent authority had constituted a Visiting Team to visit the institution on 24.10.2008
- 3. AND WHEREAS the matter was placed in 139th Meeting held on 00th to 12th April 2009. The Northern Regional Committee after considering the application and reply submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, was satisfied that the applicant institution does not full fill the requirements and has decided to refuse recognition of the institution. Accordingly, Refusal order was issued vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-73/HR-1650/2009/1039-1046 dated 23.04.2009.
- 4. AND WHEREAS the institution has preferred an appeal on **23.09.2009** against the refusal order of NRC **dated 23.04.2009** to the Appellate Authority. After perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was no justification to accept the appeal and that it should be rejected. Accordingly, the appeal was rejected and NRC's order dated 23.04.2009 was confirmed.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the order of the Council the institution filed a writ petition no. 13760/2009 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court in their order 21.02.2010 holding that the documents placed on record do not give the correct built-up area, directed the respondents to re-inspect the institution on two issues (i) with regard to the built-up area of the institution and (2) the area of multi-purpose hall. in pursuance of the order a two member team visited institute on 13.03.2010 and reported that (i) the total built-up area available to the institution on the campuses which would include office space classrooms, hall, toilets, common room, corridors, pantry, canteen etc. and also rooms which are on the first floor would measure more than 1500 Sq. Mts. and (ii) the space demarcated as multi-purpose hall which has walls on three sides and opens into the corridor on one side measures 1500 Sq. ft. (excluding corridor space). The team also mentioned that from the construction it was apparent that the hall has been extended.
- 6. AND WHEREAS, after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal affidavit VT report and after hearing oral arguments advance during the hearing the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse NRC's order dated 23.04.2009, with direction to the NRC for issuance of formal recognition order from the academic session 2010-2011, subject to the condition contained in clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations.
- 7. AND WHEREAS, The original file of the institution, reply of the Institution along with all other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines of NCTE published from time to time were considered by the Northern Regional Committee in its 160th Meeting held form 18th to 20th May, 2010 and the committee decides to issue letter under clause 7(11) of regulations 2007.
- 8. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Pratap College of Education, VPO- Jundla, Distt-Karnal, Haryana,** or conducting **B.Ed.** Course of **one** year duration with an annual intake of **100 (One Hundred only)** Students from the academic session **2010-2011** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following:
- 9. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- 10. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

- The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- 12. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.
- 13. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the format is enclosed with the order.
- 14. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
- 15. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -
 - Copy of the Application Form
 - · Land and Building Particulars
 - Staff Profile
 - · Recognition letter
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
- 16. In case if the land is in the name of the Society, you must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.
