RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution had submitted application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for Teacher Education Course.

- 2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography and also the reply submitted by the institution against letter of intent under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (earlier 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009), the Northern Regional Committee in its 261st meeting held from 14th to 19th December, 2016 is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programme, such as, instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
- 3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to the following Institution for conducting Teacher Education Course with an annual intake mentioned against its name from the academic session 2017-2018 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below:

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provides that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by the Council within five years of such recognition."
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) As per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the following norms have been prescribed for staff/ qualifications/administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc.

NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR MASTER OF EDUCATION PROGRAMME LEADING TO THE MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.ED.) DEGREE – Regarding Staff

6.1 Faculty

For an intake of 50 students per unit, the faculty student ratio for a two-year programme for 100 students shall be 1:10. The faculty positions shall be distributed as under: -

1. Professors Two
2. Associate Professors Two

The faculty members shall be appointed to cover all the core and specialised areas given in the curriculum. The Principal of a college offering M.Ed. programme shall be in the rank and scale of a professor.

6.2 Qualifications

- A. Principal / HOD
 - (i) Postgraduate degree in related discipline.
 - (ii) M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks.
 - (iii) Ph.D in Education.
 - (iv) Ten years of Professional experience in Teacher Education.
- B. Professor and Associate Professor
 - Postgraduate degree with minimum 55% marks in the discipline relevant to the area of specialisation.
 - (ii) Postgraduate degree in Education (M.Ed./M.A Education) with minimum 55% marks.
 - (iii) Ph.D. degree in Education or in the discipline relevant to the area of specialisation.
 - (iv) Any other qualifications prescribed by UGC like NET qualification or length professional teaching experience as per UGC or state government norms for the positions of professor and Associate Professor.
- C. Assistant Professor
 - (i) Postgraduate degree with minimum 55% marks in the discipline relevant to the area of specialisation.
 - (ii) Postgraduate degree in Education (M.Ed./M.A. Education) with minimum 55% marks.
 - (iii) Any other qualifications prescribed by UGC like NET qualification.

Note: - Faculty can be utilised for teaching in a flexible manner so as to optimise academic expertise available).

- 6.3 Administrative and Professional Support Staff
- (a) The following administrative staff shall be provided:

(b) In the University Education Departments, the administrative staff shall be deployed as per the policy of the University.

6.4 Terms and conditions Service

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of superannuation and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating body.

- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter

- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
- 7. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the institution, failing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.
- 8. The Education Institution shall follow uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.
- 9. The Institution shall fill the GIS application within one month of issue of this order.
- 10. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
- 11. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.india.org within 60 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
